Safe Sport June 2020 Update

Six CSI teams have now been awarded the Safe Sport Recognized Club status with USA Swimming Safe Sport. They are: Thames Aquatic Club, WHAT, Wilton Y Wahoos, LEHY, Cheshire Y and Weston Swimming. I am working with several more coaches on the application process.

Last week in the National Safe Sport meeting they announced that they want 100% of teams to achieve Recognized Club status by the end of 2021. While they have not set an end date, in the future they will be requiring all teams that host a USA Swimming sanctioned meet to be Recognized Clubs. To that end USA Swimming will be offering \$500 to the first 1,500 clubs to achieve SS Recognized Club status. Approximately 400 USA Swimming clubs have achieved this already.

If you don't know how to get started I have outlined five steps below:

- 1. Read through the SSRP webpage https://www.usaswimming.org/utility/safe-sport-recognition-program
- 2. Find your club type in the 'Guidelines' section, click the link and read through the application requirements
- 3. Identify the missing requirements and a plan to collect evidence for all requirements
- 4. Obtaining the Parent training requirement is difficult, direct your athlete's parents to the weekly USA Swimming online parent training class. https://www.usaswimming.org/docs/default-source/safe-sportdocuments/safe-sport-recognition-program/ssrp-training-resources.pdf
- 5. Complete all requirements, submit them through the Club portal and work with USA Swimming Safe Sport to respond to gaps and questions
