LOCATION: University of Connecticut. The pool is a 6-lane, 50 meter pool,

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 2006 USA Swimming Rules will govern this meet.
- The meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet.
- Connecticut Swimming warm-up procedures will be used.
- The Meet Manager reserves the right to assign general warm-up by team rather than age or sex, if the size of the entry and consideration of safety so require.
- The Meet Manager reserves the right to combine sessions, cancel relays, limit the amount of heats in the 400 distance events, cut the 4th individual event, and/or adjust start times, subject to the approval of CSI Program Operations.
- Video and photo phones may not be used during this event.
- All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming coach card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck.

HANDICAPPED/ELDERLY ACCESSIBILITY: Handicapped accessible, no step to pool deck, Spectator seating is also handicapped accessible. Any questions should be directed to the meet manager.

ENTRIES:

- The meet is open to all CSI teams as well as to any out-of-state teams.
- Entries must be received by 6:00 PM **May 31, 2006**.
- Connecticut Swimming teams whose entries are received by **May 16, 2006** will be entered in the meet first. After that date, CT Swimming and out-of-state teams will be accepted based on date/time the entries (including check) are received, until the meet is full. Formal team entry date is determined by the date of entry hard copy and entry fee receipt by host team.
- If the entries are sent via overnight mail, **please waive the “signature required.”**
- Swimmers must be registered members of USA Swimming, please make sure to include their up-to-date registration numbers with the entry. USA Swimming rules will be followed.
- Age group will be determined by age as of June 10, 2006.
- Swimmers are limited to four (4) individual events, **excluding relays** per day. **The 4th individual must be identified in the event the meet is oversubscribed.**
- *Entries are to be submitted in long course meter times.*
- **Cut Protocol:** 1st – 7/U swimmers, 2nd – relays, 3rd – 4th individual event, then 5th - date of entry. Teams will be notified of changes by June 3, 2006.
- All teams are encouraged to send their entry on disk using the LSA Swim Meet /Swim Team program or Hytek (or other program) in USA Standard Data Interchange Format (USS.SD3 file, or cfile01.cl2). **A disk must accompany all computer-generated entries.** If you choose to send your entry by email you must still mail a paper copy with your check for your entry to be considered valid, or an email equivalent Adobe Acrobat pdf file for exact printout. Entries are deemed received when sent and received by email, provided paper copy and check is received within three business days of email receipt.

- **Unattached** swimmers must be clearly indicated in **red** alongside the swimmer's name. Information contained on the original computer generated paper copy will be considered the official document of the entry and supersedes any information contained on electronic disk or file with respect to resolution of errors/discrepancies. Meet results will be provided on disk to any team submitting its entries on disk.
- *Teams with 10 or more swimmers will be assessed \$1 per swimmer if the entry is submitted on paper, without a disk.*
- Entry Chair persons are required to put an email address with the entry as well as a phone number. This email address should be the point of contact for all information and inquiries concerning the meet, changes to the meet and worker assignment information.

TIME TRIALS: Time trials will be conducted on a time available basis for swimmers participating in the meet at the discretion of the meet referee.

AWARDS: 1st through 6th in individual events and 1st through 3rd in relays. Awards will not be mailed or saved. They must be picked up by the end of the Sunday session.

WORK ASSIGNMENTS: Teams will be required to supply timers in proportion to the size of their entry. **Please note that timers are required for the whole session.** Qualified officials interested in working at the meet are encouraged to contact the Meet Referee or indicate their interest by attachments to the meet entry form. The timing assignments will be adjusted for clubs who provide officials, if the names of the officials are known by May 31, 2006.

For the Saturday afternoon Senior 400 Free, swimmers must supply their own timer.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will receive scratch sheets in the information packets. **Scratch sheets must be returned within 30 minutes after the start of warm-ups** or as indicated in the coach's packet.

CONCESSIONS AND HOSPITALITY: Concessions will be made available for athletes and spectators at a fee. Drinks will be made available to timers at no charge. Refreshments and food will be available to all coaches and officials courtesy of CAC.

DIRECTIONS: Take I-84 East/West to Exit 68. Travel south on Route 195 for about 6 miles. Proceed through the 195/44 intersection and travel approximately 1 mile to the Storrs campus. Take a right onto North Eagleville Road. Take your next left onto Glenbrook Road. At the next stop sign take a left onto Hillside Road, the pool will be approximately one block up on the right. Parking is located in the parking garage just past the pool and Gampel Pavilion. All cars parked on Hillside Road will be ticketed and towed at the owner's expense.
