The meet will be run in accordance with USA swimming rules unless otherwise noted. The meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet, with prior approval from CT program operations. All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming coach Card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck. Meet management reserves the right to limit heats, adjust warm-up, and/or start times, or make other changes to ensure a quality meet. All changes are subject to approval by CSI Program Operations.

Pool: The Melissa Nickel Pool at the Wilton Family Y pool is a 6-lane by 50 meter facility with non-turbulent lane lines and electronic timing. Adequate seating and parking are available. Parking is available across the street at the Wilton High School. The Kiddy pool is not available to meet participants. It is for the use of the Wilton Y Members and their guests. **All 12/under children must be supervised by an adult when in any area of the Wilton Y except the locker rooms and pool deck.** Handicap/Elderly accessibility to Pool deck and spectator area is accessible through men's and women's locker rooms.

Events: All events will be swum as timed finals and will be deck seeded.

Eligibility: Only 2006 CSI registered members of USA Swimming are eligible. The swimmer's age as of June 25, 2006 will determine his/her age for the meet.

Entry Limitations: Swimmers may enter up to 3 individual events. A fourth event can be selected from 200 Back, 200 Breast, and 200 Fly. If time permits, limited heats of these events will be swum. If your swimmer makes it into one of these events, you will need to select another event to scratch. The decision on who will be swimming events 21-26 will be made prior to the meet

Time Trials: Time permitting, no cost.

Cut Protocol: Team entries will be taken on a first come basis until the meet is full. (meet must end at 10 am)

Entry forms: Entries on disks in the USA Standard Data Interchange Format (SDIF) will be accepted. All entries on disk must be accompanied by original paper copy of the entry. Please ZIP your entry and attach it to an email note to WYWahoos@msn.com. Mail your entry to Wilton Y Wahoos at the above address. Please send your original entry, not a photocopy. The **phone number** of a club representative that can be reached in the evening, must be included on the form as well as a club mailing address. If any of your swimmers are swimming the meet Unattached please mark **UNAT** clearly in **RED** alongside the swimmer's name on the entry sheet. In case of dispute, the official entry form will be considered the master form and only official document of entry

Entry Fees: None

Entry Deadline: Wednesday, June 21 Entries will be on first come first serve basis until sessions are full. In state teams only.

Timers and Officials: The host team will require timers from teams in proportion to the size of their entries. Officials will also be needed. Please contact Peter Lebovitz, Head Referee if you will be able to assist, 203-966-7087 or email peter.lebovitz@managersinvest.com.

Scratches: Coaches will receive a scratch sheet in their information packet, listing all of their swimmers and events. Coaches must indicate all scratches or none on these sheets and turn them in to the computer table within **15 minutes** of the beginning of warm-ups.

Information: Please direct all questions regarding entries to the chairman and all other questions to the meet director. Since we are the guest of the Wilton Family Y, all swimmers, coaches, and guests are expected to treat the facility with respect. It is the responsibility of each team to provide supervision for the swimmers when they are not swimming. **Any violations of the rules of sportsmanship and common courtesy could result in the expulsion of a swimmer and/or team from the meet.**

Meet Schedule: Warm-Up 7 am – 7:40 Meet 7:40 – 10 am (meet must be completed by 10 am)

Directions: Wilton Family Y

Merritt Parkway from New Haven: Take exit 41(RT. 33) at end of the ramp turn left (north) onto RT. 33. Go 5.0 miles to the sixth traffic light. The Wilton Family Y is on the right, and the Wilton High School is on the left. Turn into the parking lot. Additional parking is available across the street at the high school if needed.

Merritt Parkway from New York: Take exit 39B. Follow the Route 7 North freeway to its end and turn right at the light. Turn left onto Rt. 7 north. Go 4.4 miles and turn right into the Y parking lot. The Wilton Family Y is on the right, and the Wilton High School is on the left. Additional parking is available across the street from the Y at the high school if needed.

Connecticut Turnpike I95: Take exit 15 to route 7 north. Follow Route 7 freeway to the end and turn right at the light. At the end of the road turn left onto old Route 7 and go about 3 miles to the Wilton Y as above.
