## **COACHES CREDENTIALS:**

All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming Coach Card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck.

## **HANDICAP/ELDERLY ACCESS:**

Limited handicapped parking is available. There are several steps to get into the pool area. Anyone needing access should contact the Meet Director for assistance before the meet. The facility is not yet wheelchair accessible while construction continues in other areas.

## **POOL DESCRIPTION:**

The Wren-Weisenburger Pool at the Greenwich YMCA pool is a newly built indoor, eight 9-foot lanes, 50 Meter Olympic sized pool with fast gutter system and Kiefer Advantage II lane dividers. It is located at 50 East Putnam Avenue on the corner of Mason Street in the heart of downtown Greenwich, CT. There are temporary bleachers for spectators but deck space is limited for teams. State of the art Colorado Timing System with a large LED scoreboard will be used for the meet.

**ENTRY FEES:**

\$4.00 for individual events. \$8 for relay events.

All entries must be accompanied by a single check in payment, payable to:  
Greenwich YMCA. Marlins. Swim Team.

Check must be received by Thursday May 29th or your entry may be refused.

**NOTE:** Any team entering more than 1 swimmer without electronic entry (disk or email)  
must add \$5.00 per swimmer.

**ENTRY DEADLINE:**

Entries must be received no later than 7:00 PM Thursday, May 29th, 2008.

CT teams will be entered first followed by out-of-state teams.

Any entry received after the deadline will be returned, unless the meet is undersubscribed.

Fire or town regulations may limit the number of swimmers or spectators allowed in the pool area.

**ENTRY FORMAT:**

Open to all 2008 USA Swimming registered swimmers, 11 years and older.

Please include USA registration numbers and age of all swimmers.

**All entries should be submitted with long course meter times.**

**Please convert or estimate entry times if necessary but no "No Time" entries, please.**

All entries should be sent to the Entry Chair as a zipped entry file (sd3, or cl2) by email attachment  
or on a Windows format disk/CD using LSA, HyTek, or other fully compatible team data program.

Any emailed entry file must be matched by a printed copy of the entry (hard copy)  
or an equivalent emailed pdf printout (see \* below).

Mailed disk entries must be accompanied by a printed copy of the entry.

Separate entries by age group & gender.

Identify unattached swimmers with red ink on entry printouts or by separate email.

**Hytek Users:** do not create an "UN" club. Instead, mark unattached swimmers on the hard copy.

Include in the entry the name, address, telephone number, and email address of the head coach  
and of a club official responsible for the team's entry.

***In case of dispute, the paper entry will be considered the only official document of entry.***

**ENTRY LIMITATIONS:**

The meet will be open to eligible USA Swimming, Inc. registered teams and swimmers.

All entered swimmers must be at least 11 years old on or before June 7th, 2008.

Entries are limited to **4** individual events per session and **8** individual events per meet.

### **OVERSUBSCRIPTION:**

Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, except that Connecticut teams' entries received by 6:00 PM on May 26<sup>th</sup> will have priority. *Out-of-state entries received prior to May 26<sup>th</sup> will be considered to have been received on May 26<sup>th</sup>.* Be aware the meet may close prior to the entry deadline. Teams whose entries cannot be accepted will be notified as soon as the meet is full, but not later than May 31st, 2008.

Out of state teams *must* submit a roster of swimmers signed by their LSC registration chairman *or* other acceptable proof that each swimmer is USA registered. The host team reserves the right to enter swimmers in order to provide workers to run the meet.

### **CUT PROTOCOL:**

There will be one session per day.

**If the number of swimmers plus anticipated spectators exceeds fire and/or town regulations 11 yr old swimmers, and teams may be cut by reverse order of receipt.**

**If the projected session timeline exceed 4 hours cuts may be made in the following order:**

11 year-olds, Relays, 4th events, heat limits in the 200 M events, then teams in reverse order of receipt.

The Sponsor reserves the right to make any and all adjustments as necessary to achieve an acceptable timeline, with the approval of Program Operations, based on the projected timeline.

Teams will be notified in advance by email of any changes including to the meet format ASAP, but no later than May 31st, 2008.

### **AWARDS:**

Medals will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> place for individual events only for both the 13 & Over, and the 11-12 age groups. Awards may be available for pickup at the awards room at the completion of each session. Awards will NOT be mailed.

### **WORK ASSIGNMENTS:**

All teams will be required to provide timers in proportion to the size of their team entry.

Timer assignments will be emailed to all teams prior to the meet. It is the responsibility of each team representative or coach to make sure that their timers report for the timers' meeting and remain in place.

If timers need to be relieved, it is their team's responsibility to replace them.

Timers are expected to remain on deck until the completion of all events.

A full complement of officials is important to the success of any meet. Please email the Entry Chair with a list of officials from your team who would be available to work one or more sessions.

### **RULES:**

Current USA Swimming rules will govern. All events will be timed finals.

**REFRESHMENTS:**

Coaches and Officials lunches will be provided at the meet.  
Refreshments will be available for purchase by swimmers & spectators.

**DIRECTIONS:**

**From I-95, exit 4**

From I-95 Northbound turn left; from I-95 Southbound turn right, onto Indian Field Road; continue on Indian Field Road for approx.1 mile to traffic light at East Putnam Avenue intersection; turn left onto East Putnam Avenue, go through 6 traffic lights (approx. 1-1/10 mile) turn left into parking lot of the YMCA just before the 7th traffic light. Follow driveway around to underground car park.

**From Merritt Parkway exit 31, North Street**

From Northbound I-95 bear left off exit to stop sign and turn left onto North Street.  
From Southbound I-95 turn right at end of exit ramp onto North Street (southbound).

Proceed approximately 4 miles to end of North Street, at Maple Avenue.  
Turn left onto Maple Avenue following signs to Greenwich Business District.  
At first traffic light bear right onto East Putnam Avenue.  
Go through next 2 lights (@ 0.2 mile) turn left into parking lot of the Greenwich Family YMCA.  
Follow driveway around to underground car park.

**PARKING:**

If the YMCA’s car park is full please drop off swimmers safely and continue out of the YMCA lot. Look for signs for the secondary YMCA parking lot on left of Mason Street beyond the YMCA. You may also park across the street at the Mason Street office of Chase Bank if the Bank is closed.

**PLEASE be considerate of the YMCA’s neighbors by not parking in the lots of the commercial establishments in the neighborhood nor on the roads immediately outside them.  
Cars parked in these areas will be towed.**
