## Pool Facility:

- 5 lane 50 meter pool with no timing system.
- Pool and bleachers are Handicapped Accessible. Limited seating (bring folding chairs for balcony) and parking is available.
- Concession area is also available.

## Eligibility:

- All swimmers must be 2008 registered members of USA Swimming.
- Age is determined by the swimmer's age as of June 14, 2008.
- All Coaches must be 2008 registered members of USA Swimming.
- All Coaches must present a valid USA Swimming coaches' card to the meet director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet and must have this card while on deck.

## Events:

- All Events will be swum as timed finals.
- USA Swimming rules will govern the meet.
- Entries are to be submitted in best meter times (please have your computer convert).
- Swimmers can enter and compete in as many as 4 events per day.
- Manual timing at the Yale practice pool. Therefore we will need at least 2 timers for every lane.

## Entry Fee:

- All events are \$5.00 each.
- Make all checks payable to **SHARKS!!**
- Mail the check with entry form to the entry chair above. If you send your entry by express mail, please sign the waiver so that the package will be delivered even if no one is there to sign for it.
- There will be a \$1.00 surcharge for each swimmer; for five or more hand entered entries.

## Entry Deadline:

- Entries are accepted on first come, first serve basis.
- All entries must be received by May 19, 2008. CT teams will be entered first.
- Formal entry is determined by the date of receipt of the hard copy of the entry and the entry fee.

### Cut Procedure

- All entries accepted on first come, first served basis.
- If cuts are necessary, 7/under swimmers will be cut first.
- Then swimmers will be limited to 3 events per day.
- All teams will be notified as soon as possible of any cuts.

### Times of the meet:

- Meet management reserves the right to limit heats and adjust warm up and/or start times, upon the approval of CT Swimming Program Operations.

### Entry Form:

- Open to all 2008 USA Swimming registered swimmers.
- Entry should include USA registration number and age of all swimmers.
- Please identify all unattached swimmers with red ink.
- Entries must be on Hy-Tek, LSA, or other SDIF format, but must be accompanied by a computer printout. Include on the entry form, the team name, address, and telephone of the head coach and/or club official responsible for the team's entry.
