MEET CLASSIFICATION: OPEN

LOCATION: Southern Connecticut State University. The pool is an 8-lane, 25 yards, Colorado timing/Myriad Display will be used.

TIME: Saturday and Sunday AM session: 7:30 warm-up 8:45 start
Saturday and Sunday PM session: 1:00 warm-up 2:15 start

USA Swimming Rules will govern this meet. The meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet. Fly-over starts may be used in the case of oversubscription as determined by meet referee and meet manager, with proper protocol training of officials from Officials Chairman.

Connecticut Swimming warm-up procedures will be used. The Meet Manager reserves the right to assign general warm-up by team rather than age or sex, if the size of the entry and consideration of safety so require. The Meet Manager also reserves the right to combine sessions, cancel relays, limit the amount of heats in the 400 & 500 distance events, cut the 4th individual event, and/or adjust start times, subject to the approval of CSI Program Operations.

HANDICAPPED/ELDERLY ACCESSIBILITY: Handicapped accessible, no step to pool deck, Spectator seating is also handicapped accessible. Any questions should be directed to the meet manager.

ENTRIES: Entries must be received by 6:00 PM January 27, 2004. Connecticut Swimming teams whose entries are received by January 27, 2004 will be entered in the meet first. After

that date, CT Swimming and out-of-state teams will be accepted based on date/time the entries (including check) are received, until the meet is full. Formal team entry date is determined by the date of entry hard copy and entry fee receipt by host team.

If the entries are sent via overnight mail, **please waive the “signature required”**.

Swimmers must be registered members of USA Swimming, please make sure to include their up-to-date registration numbers with the entry. Age group will be determined by age as of February 7, 2004. Swimmers are limited to four (4) individual events, **excluding relays** per day. **The 4th individual must be identified in the event the meet is oversubscribed.**
Entries are to be submitted in short course yard times.

Cut Protocol: 1st – 7/U swimmers, 2nd – relays, 3rd – 4th individual event. Teams will be notified of changes by February 4, 2003.

Coaches will required to display USA Swimming registration card in order to be on deck.

All teams are encouraged to send their entry on disk using the LSA Swim Meet /Swim Team program or Hytek (or other program) in USA Standard Data Interchange Format (.SD3 file). **A disk must accompany all computer-generated entries.** If you choose to send your entry by email you must still mail a paper copy with your check for your entry to be considered valid, or an email equivalent Adobe Acrobat pdf file for exact printout.

Unattached swimmers must be clearly indicated in **red** alongside the swimmer’s name. Information contained on the original computer generated paper copy will be considered the official document of the entry and supersedes any information contained on electronic disk or file with respect to resolution of errors/discrepancies. Meet results will be provided on disk to any team submitting its entries on disk.

Teams with 10 or more swimmers will be assessed \$1 per swimmer if the entry is submitted on paper, without a disk.

Entry Chair persons are encouraged to put an E-Mail address with the entry as well as a phone number.

ENTRY FEES: Splash Fee: \$3 per individual event, \$6 per relay and \$5 per time trial.

TIME TRIALS: Time trials will be conducted on a time available basis for swimmers participating in the meet at the discretion of the meet referee.

AWARDS: Ribbons 1st through 8th in individual events and 1st through 3rd in relays. Awards will not be mailed or saved. They must be picked up by the end of the Sunday session.

WORK ASSIGNMENTS: Teams will be required to supply timers in proportion to the size of their entry. **Please note that timers are required for the whole session.** Qualified officials interested in working at the meet are encouraged to contact the Meet Referee or indicate their interest by attachments to the meet entry form. The timing assignments will be adjusted for clubs who provide officials, if the names of the officials are known by February 4, 2004.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will receive scratch sheets in the information packets. **Scratch sheets must be returned within 20 minutes after the start of warm-ups** or as indicated in the coaches packet.

DIRECTIONS: *From New York:* I-95, Exit 44 (Kimberly Avenue, Route 10). Turn right at the end of the exit onto Kimberly Avenue, then left at the stoplight onto Ella Grasso Boulevard, Route 10. Ella Grasso Boulevard ends at Crescent Street, near the south entrance to the campus.

Also From New York: Merritt-Wilbur Cross Parkway, Exit 59 (Whalley Avenue.) Head south on Whalley Avenue, turn left onto Fitch Street, which bisects the campus.

From New London: I-95, Exit 45 (Ella Grasso Boulevard, Rout 10). Follow Ella Grasso Boulevard north. Ella Grasso Boulevard ends at Crescent Street, near the south entrance to the campus.

From Hartford: Wilbur Cross Parkway, Exit 60 at Dixwell Avenue. Head south on Dixwell Avenue to Arch Street. Turn right at Arch Street and left at Fitch Street, which bisects the campus.

Parking will only be allowed in the student lots adjacent to the Moore Field House. There will be no parking available in the faculty lots.
