**Pool:** One 6 lane, 25 yard course with electronic timing

**Handicap/Elderly Access:** The spectator area is NOT handicapped accessible. Spectators needing accommodation can enter on the pool level, where an area will be set aside for spectators. The pool level is accessible and has handicapped accessible bathrooms.

**Events:** All events will be deck seeded timed finals. Relay swimmers only must be listed on entry.

**Eligibility:** Only 2003 USA/CSI registered swimmers are eligible and must be registered prior to the entry deadline. USA Swimming rules will govern the meet. USA Swimming rules will govern the meet. USA Swimming Protocol (102.14.2 C and 102.14.4 H) will be followed. The meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet. Coaches will be required to show their up to date USA Swimming registration card before picking up their teams packet and scratch sheets. **Only coaches with current USA registration will be allowed on deck with no exceptions.**

**Entry Limitations:** Swimmers may enter events for which they are qualified but are limited to **4** individual events per session. Swimmers' **4<sup>th</sup>** event must be circled in case of over-subscription. The host team reserves the right to scratch the **4<sup>th</sup>** event, eliminate relays, limit or eliminate 7 and 8 year old entries, or limit the number of heats for any event. The host team also reserves the right to decide which actions is taken first, second and so forth, in case of over-subscription. Fly-over starts may be used in case of over-subscription as determined by the meet referee and the meet manager, with proper protocol training of officials from the Officials Chairman. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Unattached swimmers should be clearly marked in **red**.

**Entry Format:** Open to all 2003 Connecticut registered swimmers. Please include USA registration numbers and age of all swimmers. Identify unattached swimmers with **red ink**. No time (NT) entries are discouraged. Relay only swimmers must be included on the entry form.

Teams are encouraged to submit entries either via e-mail at *Fermin1@comcast.net* if attached in a zip file or a computer disk using LSA swim team program or any other program in the USA SWIMMING .SD3 or CL2 formats. An original computer generated copy of the entry with all pertinent team information and entry totals must be included. The name, phone number, email address and mailing address of a club contact must be included with the entry. Any computer-generated entry may be **submitted by either e-mail or on a disk**. Official CSI entry form must be submitted in lieu of a disk.

**Entry Deadline:** The "CT team" only deadline date of Oct.22. After that date, out of state entries will be accepted. The final deadline for both CT and out of state teams is Nov. 1. **Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Formal entry date is determined by the date of entry hard copy and entry fees check receipt by the Entry Chair.** If using Express mail, remember to sign the waiver so package will be left.

**Entry Fees:** Individual events are \$3.00 and relay events are \$6.00. Please make checks payable to C.A.T. and include with entry form.

**Work Assignments:** Teams will be required to provide timers and workers based on size of entry.

**If your team has an official who would be able to assist with the meet, please submit their name with the entry.**

**Scratches:** Coaches will receive a scratch sheet for each session of the meet in their information packet. Coaches must indicate all scratches or none on these sheets and turn them in to the computer table 1/2 hour prior to the end of warm-up.

**Awards:** Individual event awards will be given.

**Concessions:** Food and beverage will be available for purchase.

**Directions:** Route 9 North or South, take Exit 9, Route 81 South. 1<sup>st</sup> light, turn right onto Little City Road. HK HS is second left (Note: past Middle School).

**Information:** Remember we are guests of H/K High School and therefore all swimmers, coaches and guests are expected to treat the facility with respect. It is the responsibility of each team to supervise their swimmers when they are not swimming. Any violations of the CT. Code of Conduct will result in expulsion of swimmer and or team.
