Meet Classification:	Open
Entry Fee:	\$4.00 individual events, \$8 for relays Manual entry fee: If you submit hand entries. Any team entering more than 5 swimmers without an electronic entry (disk or email) must add \$3.00 per swimmer.
Entry Limitations:	4 per session subject to maximum of 5 per day if a swimmer is entered in both sessions
Cut Protocol:	Meet will be run in two sessions. The 12&U Mystery Meet session will be run in session I. The Senior Invite will be run in session II. In case of oversubscription the cut protocol for session I (Mystery meet) will be as follows: Swimmers will first be limited to 3 individual events. Be sure to indicate each swimmers 4 th event on the hard copy of the entry. If the 4 th event is not listed then the last event (for swimmers with 4 entries) will be considered the 4 th event and will be cut. Second, all 7/U swimmers will be cut. Third, team entries will be cut based on the order in which they were received. IN THE EVENT THAT TEAMS MUST BE CUT FROM THE MEET THE MEET MANAGER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REINSTATE THE 4th EVENT IF THE TIME LINE ALLOWS AFTER SCRATCHES. Teams will be notified in advance by email of any change.
Awards:	Ribbons place 1-6, Heat winners and "Most Mysterious Swimmer Award" to the male and female swimmer in each age group with the highest total points. There will be NO awards for session II Senior Invite.

Entry Deadline:	All entries should be submitted with short course yard times. Entries must be received no later than 6:00 P.M. Wednesday, October 25, 2006. Meet Manager reserves the right to deny any or all changes to the entry after it is received. Any entry received after the above dates will be returned, unless the meet is undersubscribed.

Oversubscription:	Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, except that Connecticut teams' entries received by 6:00 PM on October 25 th will have priority. All out-of-state entries received prior to October 26 th will be considered to have been received on that date. Be aware the meet may close prior to the entry deadline. Teams whose entries cannot be accepted will be notified as soon as the meet is full, but not later than October 27 th , 2006.
Entry Format:	<p>All entry times should be in short course yards. All Senior Events should be entered with standard seed times for that event.</p> <p>For Session 2 Age Group "Mystery Meet" events the following entry rules will apply: Stroke events must be entered with swimmers BREASTROKE seed time for that distance. All freestyle events must be entered with swimmers fastest 100 YARD Freestyle seed time. IM events will use normal IM seed times.</p> <p>All events are open to all 2006 or 2007 USA registered swimmers. There are no cut-off times for this meet. Please include USA registration numbers and age of all swimmers. Identify unattached swimmers with red ink. Relay only swimmers must be included on the entry form. All entries must be on official CSI entry form or Windows format disk using LSA, Hytek, or compatible file format. Disk entries must be accompanied by a printed copy. Include on the entry the name, address, telephone number, and email address of the head coach <u>and</u> of a club official responsible for the team's entry. In case of dispute, the paper entry form will be considered the only official document of entry. All entries must be accompanied with payment. Submit a separate entry sheet for each age group. Please avoid "NT" entries. Out of state teams <i>must</i> submit a roster of swimmers signed by the LSC registration chairman or other acceptable proof that each swimmer is USA registered.</p>

Warm-up Times:	12&U Boys & Girls 7:00AM *Warm-up times are subject to change based on the size of the meet with the Senior Boys & Girls 12:30PM approval from Program Operations.
Starting Times:	12&U Boys & Girls 8:15AM Senior Boys & Girls 1:45PM
Scratch Procedure:	Coaches will receive a scratch sheet for each session of the meet in their information packets listing all of their swimmers and events for that session. Coaches must indicate all scratches on these sheets and turn them in to the computer table within one half hour after the beginning of warm-up.
Credentials:	All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming Coach Card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck.
Refreshments:	Refreshments will be made available.
Directions:	<p>From South: Merrit Parkway to exit 37 make a left at the traffic light and head north on South avenue (Route 124) back across the parkway. Follow this road for about a half mile and the YMCA will be located on the right. Parking is located right past the YMCA at Saxe Middle School.</p> <p>From North: Merrit Parkway to exit 37. Make a left at the stop sign onto South Avenue (Rt. 124). Follow this road for about a half mile and the YMCA will be located on the right. Parking is located right past the YMCA at Saxe Middle School.</p>
Parking:	There will be no parking at the YMCA or on Putnam and Surry Roads. Parking will be located in the Saxe Middle School parking lot located adjacent to the YMCA. There will also be parking allowed on South Avenue (Route 124) on the eastbound side of the road heading toward the Merrit Parkway (side across from the YMCA).
Handicapped Access:	Access to the spectator area is by stairway only. The pool deck is at ground floor level. If special assistance is required by athletes, coaches, or spectators, please contact the Meet Director.
Comments:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All teams will be required to provide timers in proportion to the size of their team entry. Timer assignments will be emailed to all teams prior to the meet. It is the responsibility of each team representative or coach to make sure that their timers report for the timers' meeting and remain in place. If timers need to be relieved, it is their team's responsibility to replace them. Timers are expected to remain on deck until the completion of all events. - A full complement of officials is important to the success of any meet. Please email the Meet Referee with a list of officials from your team who would be available to work one or more sessions. - Swimmers entering mystery events must be able and prepared to swim any possible stroke/distance for that event. - Current USA Swimming rules will govern for standard USA Swimming events, and times will be reported to CT Swimming. Out-of-order Individual Medley and Medley Relay events are not recognized by USA Swimming and are exhibition events swum just for fun! Standard USA Swimming rules will apply for those events to the extent possible at the discretion of the Referee. They will be valid for awards but times will not be reported and swimmers cannot use them for seeding or qualification at other meets. - All events will be timed finals. - Results for the Mystery Meet Medley Relay will be considered unofficial UNLESS the strokes of the event happen to be run in the specific order established by USA Swimming.
