**Eligibility:** USA Swimming Rules will govern this meet. Coaches will be required to show their up to date USA Swimming registration card before picking up their team packet and scratch sheets. All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming coach Card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck.

**Entry Dates:** Entries are accepted on a first come, first served basis. The meet manager and meet referee reserve the right to combine sessions, cancel relays, limit the number of heats in distance events, cut the 4<sup>th</sup> event, and adjust start times based on the number of entries received, with approval from CSI Program Operations. Entries must be received by 6:00 pm, October 15, 2006; Connecticut Swimming teams whose entries are received by October 8, 2006 will be entered in the meet first. After that date, CT Swimming and out-of-state teams will be accepted based on dates/time the entries (including check) are received until the meet is full. Formal team entry date is determined by the date of entry hard copy and entry fee receipt by host team. If entries are sent via overnight mail, please waive the "signature required". Teams will be notified by Sunday, October 22, 2006 in the case of changes.

**Entry Limitations:** Swimmers may enter events for which they are qualified but are limited to 4 individual events per session. Swimmers' 4<sup>th</sup> event must be circled in case of over-subscription. In the case of oversubscription, the 7/Us will be cut first, followed by relays, and then all fourth events will be cut Connecticut Swimming warm-up procedures will be used. The Meet Manager reserves the right to assign general warm-up by team rather than age or sex, if the size of the entry and considerations of safety so require.

**Entry Format:** Open to all 2006 or 2007 USA Swimming registered swimmers. Please make sure to include their up-to-date registration numbers and age of all swimmers with the entry. Age group will be determined by age as of, October 29, 2006.

Times must be submitted in ***SHORT COURSE YARD TIMES***.

If attached in a zip file or a computer disk using HYTEK swim team program or any other program in the USA Swimming .sd3 format, an original computer generated copy of the entry with all pertinent team information and entry totals must be included. The name, phone number, email address and mailing address of a club contact must be included with the entry. Any computer-generated entry may be submitted by either e-mail or on a disk. Official CSI entry form must be submitted in lieu of a disk.

Unattached swimmers must be clearly indicated in red alongside the swimmer's name. Information contained on the original computer generated paper copy will be considered the official document of entry and supersedes any information contained on electronic disk or file with respect to resolution of errors/discrepancies. Meet results will be provided on disk to any team submitting its entries on disk. Teams with 5 or more swimmers will be assessed \$1 per swimmer if the entry is submitted on paper, without a disk.

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded for 1st to 6th place for all events, except relays which will receive ribbons for 1st to 3rd place.

**Work Assignments:** Teams will be required to supply timers in proportion to the size of their entry. Please note that timers are required for the whole session. Qualified officials interested in working at the meet are encouraged to contact the Meet Referee or indicate their interest by attachments to the meet entry form. Handicapped/Elderly Accessibility: Handicapped parking is available in the main pool parking lot. An area has been set aside on the pool deck for limited handicapped seating. Access to this area can be obtained through the women's locker room. In order that we may better prepare to assist individuals with special needs, we ask that you contact the Meet Manager, Taryn Perry at (860) 293-2492 prior to the meet.

**Scratches:** Coaches will receive scratch sheets at the beginning of the sessions. Scratch sheets must be returned within 20 minutes after the start of warm-ups.

**Directions:**

From south of Suffield: Take I-91 to Exit 38. Turn right onto RT 75(North) and continue through Windsor Locks, into Suffield (approx. 8 miles). In the center of Suffield you will pass through two lights that are twenty yards apart. Suffield Academy is immediately on the left after the second light, at then end of the town green. The pool is at the bottom of the hill, on your left.
