Name of Meet:	IM Tough Pentathlon
Meet Classification:	Open
Entry Fee:	\$4.00 individual events. Manual Entry Fee: any team entering more than five swimmers without an electronic entry either via disk or email must add \$3.00 per swimmer.
Entry Limitations:	Swimmers may compete in five events per session.
Cut Protocol/ Oversubscription:	Meet will be run in two sessions, sessions 1 and 2 will both run on Saturday. In the event that the meet is undersubscribed and the total time for both sessions is under three hours the sessions may be combined at the discretion of the meet manager with approval from Program Operations. In case of oversubscription the cut protocol will be as follows: First, the swimmers 5 th event will be cut (be sure to indicate each swimmers 5th event on the hard copy of the entry). If the 5 th event is not indicated then the last event (for swimmers entered in five events) will be considered the 5 th event and will be cut. The final cut will be whole team entries based on the order in which they were received. IN THE EVENT THAT TEAMS MUST BE CUT FROM THE MEET, THE MEET MANAGER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REINSTATE THE 5TH EVENT IF THE TIME LINE ALLOWS AFTER TEAM SCRATCHES. Teams will be notified in advance by email of any change no later than Monday October 29th.
Awards:	Top three overall swimmers in each age group will receive a trophy. Points will be awarded for the top twelve places and then totaled. In case of ties, places will be based on IM times. Swimmers must swim all five events to be eligible for a trophy. In the case of time constraints in which the swimmers fifth event is cut, the awards will be determined on overall points scored based on all of the events that the swimmer participated in, regardless of the number of events they participated in.

Entry Deadline:	All entries should be submitted with short course yard times. Entries must be received no later than 9:00pm Friday October 26 th , 2007. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, except that Connecticut teams' entries received prior to 9:00pm on Wednesday October 24 th , 2007 will have priority. All out-of-state entries received prior to the 25 th , will be considered to have been received on that date. Be aware the meet may close prior to the entry deadline. Teams whose entries cannot be accepted will be notified as soon as the meet is full, but no later than October 27 th , 2007. The meet manager reserves the right to deny any or all changes to the entry after it is received. Any entry received after the entry deadline will be returned, unless the meet is undersubscribed.
Entry Format:	All entry times should be in yards. Open to all 2007/2008 USA registered swimmers. Please include USA registration numbers and age of all swimmers. Identify UNATTACHED swimmers with red ink. No Time (NT) entries are discouraged. Please circle the fifth event for all swimmers in the case of over-subscription. Entries should be submitted on disk using Hy-Tek, LSA or other SDIF software programs, and must be accompanied by a paper copy of the entry. Include on the entry the name, address and telephone number of the head coach and a club official responsible for the team's entry. In case of dispute, the original hard copy of the entry form will be considered the only official document of entry. A check or proof of a check request must be submitted by the entry deadline.

Scratch Procedure:	Coaches will receive a scratch sheet for each session of the meet in their information packets listing all of their swimmers and events for each session. Coaches must indicate all scratches on these sheets and turn them in to the computer table within one half hour after the start of warm-up.
Credentials	All coaches must present a valid 2007/2008 USA Swimming registration card to the meet director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck.
Refreshments:	Refreshments will be made available.
Directions:	From North or South: Take the Merrit Parkway to exit 37, make a left off the exit ramp and head north on South Ave (Rte 124). Follow this road for about ¾ of a mile. The YMCA is on the right. Swimmers may be dropped off at the YMCA; however there is NO parking available. Upon making a right out of the YMCA parking lot the Saxe Middle School lot is the next drive on the right hand side. To get to the High School, after making a right out of the YMCA parking lot make a left at the first traffic light onto Farm Ave. The high school is on the left hand side.
Parking:	There will be NO PARKING AT THE YMCA. There is NO Parking on Putnam or Surray Road's. Parking will be either at the Saxe Middle School or High School. The meet manager will notify the entered teams prior to the meet.
Handicapped Access:	Access to the spectator area is by stairway only. The pool deck is at ground floor level. Please contact the meet director if athletes, coaches or spectators require special assistance.
Comments:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All Teams will be required to provide timers in proportion to the size of their team entry. Timer assignments will be emailed to all teams prior to the meet. It is the responsibility of each team representative or coach to make sure that their timers report for the timers' meeting and remain in place through out the session. If timers need to be relieved, it is their team's responsibility to provide a replacement timer. - A full complement of officials is important to the success of any meet. Please email the Meet Referee with a list of officials from your team who would be available to work one or more sessions. - Current USA Swimming rules govern and times will be reported to CT Swimming. - All events will be timed finals. - No Time Trials will be available.
