MEET CLASSIFICATION: This meet is open to all USA Swimming athletes and clubs.

MEET FORMAT: The meet will be swum as timed-finals.

SCRATCH PROCEDURES: scratches are due 30 minutes before the start of the session.

FACILITY: The Norwalk High School Pool is a 6 -lane, 25-yard pool. The meet will be run using manual timing.

DISABLED ACCESS: Handicap accessibility throughout the facility.

COURSE: SCY

SESSION TIMES: 6:45 p.m. warm up 7:30 p.m. start

WARM-UPS: CT Swimming Warm-Up Procedures will be in effect.

ELIGIBILITY: All athletes must be current athlete members of USA Swimming. Age on the first day of the meet shall determine the swimmer's age and age group for the meet. Any swimmer who is entered and is unregistered, will be scratched from the meet until registration is completed. All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming coach card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck.

ADAPTED SWIMMING: Any current athlete members of USA Swimming with a disability as defined by USA Swimming Rules and Regulations may enter this meet. If modifications to USA Swimming rules are necessary then the coach or athlete must notify the meet referee of any disability prior to competition.

EVENT INFORMATION:

- The session MUST be completed in 90 minutes from the start of the meet.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: Maximum of 5 events per day

ENTRY TIMES: Submit entry times in: SCY. No Times are discouraged.

DEADLINES: Entry deadline is Friday, January, 22, 2010.

All entries must be typed or printed legibly, and must use full names and registration numbers from USA Swimming registration.

Entries are official upon receipt of the check.

ELECTRONIC ENTRIES: Electronic entries (such as from Hy-Tek Team Manager or other team management software) that are in CL2 or SD3/SDIF format may be emailed as an attachment to the entry chair at byte1inc@optonline.net. Please check that your team name, address, and contact information are listed correctly in this file. When payment is received the entry is considered officially in the meet.

ENTRY FEES:

- Electronic entries are \$4 per event, and \$8 for relays.
- No refunds will be given for entries that are accepted, or for entries that are rejected due to improper entry

CUT PROTOCOL: Should the meet be oversubscribed the cut protocol is as follows:

- Relays will be eliminated
- Cut the events from 5 to 4 events. Then 4 events to 3 events.
- Receipt of the entry

Clubs will be notified of cuts no later than Monday before the meet.

RESERVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE CHANGES: The meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet, with prior approval from Program Operations. Clubs will be notified of cuts no later than Monday before the meet.

RELAYS: There are no relay limitations. All relay swimmers must be officially entered in the meet.

SAFETY:

1. Diving will be prohibited during warm-ups except in specifically announced one-way sprint lanes. There will be no diving in the warm-up and warm-down areas at any time

2. No shaving is permitted at the competition site.
3. No glass containers are permitted within the facility.
4. Swimmers must be under the supervision of a coach. If a swimmer arrives at the meet without a coach, the swimmer should notify the referee before he/she warms up. The referee will assign the swimmer to a registered coach for warm-ups.
5. No electronic devices with cameras are permitted in the locker rooms.

RULES: Current USA Swimming rules will govern all competition.

TIME TRIALS: Yes, Time trials will be offered at the discretion of the meet referee if time allows. Time trials are \$5.00 for individual events and \$10.00 for relays. Time trial events count toward the total number of event limitations per session.

TIMERS, OFFICIALS OR WORK ASSIGNMENTS: Volunteers will be based on the number of swimmers in the meet.

DECK ACCESS: Only athletes, coaches, officials, and official meet staff actively participating in the meet are permitted on the pool deck.

SCORING: The meet will be scored. Scoring will be the standard First through sixteenth place.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded to the top 8 finishers in all 9 and under events, and top 3 finishers in each relay event for 9 and unders. Teams are responsible for picking up their own awards.

DIRECTIONS: The Norwalk High School pool is on County Street in Norwalk, CT.
