SURCHARGE POLICY and MEET DIRECTOR'S REPORT SHORT COURSE and LONG COURSE

The only financial information that CSI requires from meet sponsors is that necessary to calculate the surcharge. It is often possible to submit this report prior to the meet, and you must submit it within fourteen days of the competition. Distance meets are not subject to a surcharge, but reports should be completed.

The short course meet surcharge is 25% of visiting team individual event entry fees, including scratched events and time trials. The long course surcharge is 15%. No surcharge is collected on relays or home team event entries.

You must submit the Surcharge report and Meet Director's report within 14 days. Up to 10 days late- \$25 withheld; 11-20 days late- \$50 withheld; 21-30 days- \$75 withheld and over 30 days- \$100 withheld from sanction deposit.
