## **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- 1. Assist head coach in creating thorough, age-appropriate workouts focusing on technique, endurance, stroke development, drills, etc.
- 2. Participate in structured practices in weekday evenings throughout the year.
- 3. Help to record all workouts and track daily attendance.
- 4. Assist head coach with administrative matters relating to the team, swim meet arrangements and team performance as well as interaction with parents.
- 5. Assist in coordinating and executing swim team competitions and meet registrations and recording times and collecting other relevant data at swim meets.
- 6. Attend swim team events such as meets, meetings, social events, etc. at the direction of the head coach.

- 11. Assist in maintaining a clean, safe, and positive environment for swim team participants.

- 2. 1+ years swim coaching experience preferred.
