FUNCTION:

It is expected that this staff person helps create a positive learning and competitive environment for the Sharks Swim Team as well as be responsible for the overall health and safety, in and around the pool. It is expected that this staff person will be responsible for assisting and/or leading a number of Sharks swim team activities and programs within the JCC facilities in coordination with the Head Coach or Head Group Coach.

Assistant coaches would ideally be able and willing to coach 2-5 days a week (4-10hrs/week). Attendance at meets is not required, but it is preferred (based on the coach's availability).

JOB QUALIFICATIONS:

- Education: Minimum 18 years of age.
- Experience 1 year experience working with young children (Individuals with equivalent work experience and appropriate training may be considered.)
- Required Licensure: First Aid, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, USA Swim Coaching Certified
- Lifeguard: not required but preferred
- ASCA Level 1 Coach or higher and WSI are a plus

- Ability to work as a team with other members of the coaching staff
- Ability to work independently without supervision
- Ability to communicate with swimmers, swim parents, colleagues and other at large JCC staff members.
- Ability to consistently deliver quality customer service

- Must have a general understanding of pool safety and rules
- Must be able to handle emergency situations in a calm manner
- Must have the ability to enforce all facility rules and policies in a gentle but firm manner to people of all ages

- Must have knowledge of skills levels for appropriate age and class
- Willing to work within philosophical framework of program

SPECIAL EQUIPMENT:

Must be proficient in the use of rescue equipment, including:

- Ring buoys
- Rescue Tubes
- Reaching Poles
- Backboard and neck collars

SPECIAL PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

- Ability to instruct participants on correct stroke technique
- Must be able to stand for long periods of time

WORK ENVIRONMENT:
