Coaching the Masters swim program and assisting in the coaching of our National, Senior and Junior training squads as needed. The Assistant Coach will work in partnership with the Head Coach, Head Age Group Coach and Aquatics Department on all aspects of the Wahoos Competitive Swim Team and Developmental Programs.

Essential Functions:

Coaching

- Act as the Assistant Coach for the Pre-Team, and all Age Group practice groups.
- Establish a positive practice environment, while teaching self-discipline, dedication, and responsibility.
- Three days a week of in water swim instruction.
- Attend all swim meets according to Competition Schedule set by Wahoos Head Coach.
- Assist/Substitute with other practice groups as needed.

- Communicate effectively with Aquatics Director, athletes, parents, and volunteers as needed.
- Complete meet entries as needed.
- Support club operations as needed.
- Attend all Staff Meetings and Assist the Head Age Group Coach and Wahoo Office Manager with necessary administrative support (i.e., Registration, other Office-work)
