Short Course Senior Meet Time Standards:

Time Standards And Bonus events were discussed. Thoughts that the cuts should be faster than 15 and Over Age Groups cuts were discussed. It is the feeling of the committee that the standards remain the same at this time.

Qualifications were discussed. Questions were raised as to when the World rankings should be recorded as they change throughout the year.
