**OLD BUSINESS**

**NEW BUSINESS**

1. Set 2017 SC Senior Championship Time Standards and Meet format
  - Meet date set by previous committee for March 9-12<sup>th</sup>, 2017 7
  - Conversation about the previous meet time standards and total entries.
    - 70<sup>th</sup> place yard time with straight LCM and SCM conversion for women and men was proposed by Jason Paige.
  - Discussion on men's conversions being slower than LCM time standards
    - Suggestion to adopt the LCM/SCM Senior Championship time standards for men was proposed by Jason Paige.
  - MOTION: To accept the proposed 2017 SC Senior Championships qualifying times with adjusted non conforming qualifying times.
    - PASSED 6-0-0 (see attachment)
  - Conversation about order of events of previous SC Championship meet was held.
  - Time line from last year was not balanced for the preliminary sessions.
  - Suggestion of moving 200 Fly to Sunday day by Jason Paige, along with running the distance events as a separate session similar to sectionals, and other national level meets (slowest to fastest with the 2<sup>nd</sup> fastest heat of men finishing at the start of the finals warm-up)
  - Discussion on final day order of events was held with the decision to keep the previous order and add the 200 fly as the first event of the day. It was decided to keep the 200yd relay events on Thursday evening; however the 200 Medley Relay would be held first, then the distance freestyle events followed by the 200 Free Relay. This decision was made to create a team atmosphere for the entire evening session.
  - Possible "flighted" meet format and "BONUS" swims were discussed but all agreed due to space limitations that it might be best at this time to stay with the traditional format and not allow bonus swims.
  - MOTION: To accept adjusted Order of Events
  - PASSED: 6-0-0 (see attachment)
2. Senior Swimming Mission and Vision – What should the CT Senior Swimming Track look like.
  - Brief discussion was held about senior swimming dedicated to swimmers of all ages, focused on being an introduction to National Championship meets.
  - MOTION: To table the development of the Senior Swimming Mission and Vision to the next SR Committee meeting.
  - PASSED : 6-0-0

3. Set Long Course Senior Meet Events Schedule

- Conversation about the format of LC Senior Championships and the possibility of an additional Senior Invite the first weekend in August.
- MOTION: To hold CT Senior Championships July 13-16, 2016 at Wesleyan University.
