NEW BUSINESS

1. Discussion on the CT Senior Championships was held. The committee is excited to run this meet in February this season. The meet event order and time standards were discussed. The decision of the committee was to keep the same order of events and gather data on time standards and to finalize time standards at the November meeting. With the meet moving to February it is believed by the committee that more high school boys will participate in the meet as well as more 13-14 age group qualifiers.
2. Discussion on the SC Senior Invite planned for March 7-10th, 2018 was held. The purpose of the meet was discussed at length and it was determined that the meet itself should provide a service for multiple levels of swimmers in CT. Opening the meet to non CT LSC teams was discussed and it was decided that non CT LSC teams would be permitted to participate; however CT teams would get priority if they submit an entry by the CT Only Deadline. Time standards will be reflective of 13-14 age group or "AA" standards (the slower of the two), bonus swims would be allowed as well. At this time it was decided to build a meet announcement and present at the November meeting for approval.
3. Athlete Travel Assistance was discussed pertaining to adding support for coaches to travel to a USA Select Camp. It was suggested that the CT Swimming at least match what USA Swimming provides for coaches travel to the Select Camp (\$200). Motion made to support the suggestion, which passed unanimously.
4. The Elite Training Camp was tabled for the November meeting.
