Additionally, we will ask every team to answer a few questions through a online **FAST submittal** that includes – but not limited to:

- Is your facility opening for your team to get back in the water?
  - If not, please explain why your facility is not opening
  - What facility/facilities do you use for practice?
- > When is your starting date to get your team back in the water?
- > Are you able to get you whole team back in the water?
  - If you are being limited:
    - Why?
    - How are you determining who will invited to practice

We are looking to get as much information as possible to see what we can do to help get your swimmers back in the pool and you back on deck. I make no promises, but we will do what we can to help.

I spoke briefly regarding the latest with the Connecticut Swimming Stimulus program. <u>Here</u> is what I posted at the meeting. For those of you looking to apply for operational funding, you will be able to do so online in the near future – again through FAST Club Administration dashboard. ALL applications will be held in the strictest confidence possible. Please be sure you upload the requested documents and answer the questions to the best of your ability.

Our Ad-Hoc Committee of Jason Paige, Mark Wollen and Nick Cavataro will meet Thursday, June 11 to get some ideas generated and start to build a game plan for what competitions will may look like as we head into the fall.
