

Meet hosts conducting USA/CT Swimming sanctioned meets are obligated to verify the membership status of athletes, coaches, officials, and meet directors participating in a sanctioned meet and/or serving in an official capacity.

## Athlete Membership Verification

- Connecticut Swimming athlete verification may be checked by host club using **Connecticut** <u>FAST</u>. Log into your club's Connecticut <u>FAST</u> Administration page or your <u>FAST</u> My Account and select Meet Verification File from the search menu. (Go to Meets section.) Upload the exported membership file from your meet software. The query will return a list of athletes flagged for registration/membership errors:
  - Athletes without current USA Swimming registration.
    - Notify coach and re-run membership verification prior to the meet. Athlete must be registered before competing regardless of host and participating club communications.
  - Athletes with USA IDs that don't match the membership record for that athlete. These athletes may or may not be registered.
    - Connecticut Swimming athlete USA ID numbers are available using Connecticut <u>FAST</u>. Log into your club's FAST Administration page. Click on Swimmer Registration Check under Reports. Click on the Team dropbox and select Swimmer from another team.
    - Make corrections to USA ID numbers in meet database.
    - Notify coach if the athlete isn't registered or has a USA ID that doesn't match the ID on file.
    - Notify office if USA ID in the membership report is incorrect.
    - Athletes entered under a different club than they are registered with.
      - Any member athlete may enter as unattached (UN) even if registered with a club.
      - If registered as UN, then the athlete cannot compete affiliated with a club.
  - Adult Athletes 18/O with no Athlete Protection Training on file
    - Notify coach that adult athlete must complete APT before competing. Re-run membership file before prior to meet to confirm adult athlete has complete APT.
  - Athletes registered as Flex members that have already swum the 2-meet maximum.
    - Notify the coach that the athlete must be "upgraded" to premium membership before competing.
    - Re-run membership file before prior to meet to confirm adult athlete has complete APT.
  - Clubs without current USA Swimming membership (unregistered)
    - Clubs must compete UN and club name, mascot, etc is not to be used.
      - Change club to LSC-UN (LSC Unattached)
      - Notify unregistered clubs that they are not a USA Swimming club.
- Out-of-State athletes must be verified by the CSI office or the LSC of the visiting club. Meet hosts should email a membership file to <a href="mailto:ctswim.mccurdy@gmail.com">ctswim.mccurdy@gmail.com</a> when out of state teams are participating. Please send this file immediately after all out-of-state entries are received.
- Unregistered athletes and adult athletes 18/O without Athlete Protection Training may not compete in sanctioned meets. There are no exceptions. Failure to verify membership or APT and/or permitting an unregistered athlete to swim will result in a monetary fine to the meet host.

## **Coach Membership Verification**

• Every individual acting in a coaching capacity at a meet must be asked to show a current USA Swimming Coach card on USA Swimming Deck Pass Plus.

- CSI posts on its website and emails each meet host a roster of current Connecticut Swimming coaches.
- Failure to verify coaches and/or permitting a coach on deck to coach may result in a monetary fine.

## **Official Verification**

• The Meet Referee will check membership credentials for officials, unless other arrangements have been made between the Referee and Meet Director.

## **Meet Director**

- All Meet Directors must be registered non-athlete members in good standing with USA Swimming on or before the day the meet announcement is approved by CSI Program Operations. Failure to do so may result in a monetary fine.
