MEET CLASSIFICATION: This meet is open to all USA Swimming athletes and clubs.

MEET FORMAT: The meet will be swum as timed-finals

SCRATCH PROCEDURES: Coaches will receive a list of their swimmers and the events in which they are entered at each session. All scratches for that session will be due at the main desk 20 minutes before the start of the session. Swimmers who fail to appear for the start of their race shall be disqualified from that race.

FACILITY: The Larry Hart Competition Pool is an 8 -lane, 25-meter pool: The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). Water depth at start end is: 12.06 feet. Water depth at turn end is: 4.09 feet. Colorado electronic timing system. There is sufficient deck space with limited spectator seating in the balcony.

DISABLED ACCESS: Handicapped parking is available, pool and locker rooms are handicapped accessible. Please contact the meet manager if special arrangements are needed.

COURSE: SCM.

EVENTS: See attached list.

SESSION TIMES: Warm-up: 8am; Start: 9:10am

WARM-UPS: CT Swimming Warm-Up Procedures will be in effect.

ELIGIBILITY: All athletes must be 12 years or under and a current member of USA Swimming. Age on the day of the meet shall determine the swimmer's age and age group for the meet. Any swimmer, who is entered and is unregistered, will be scratched from the meet until registration is completed. See CT Swimming athlete registration procedures. Registrations will not be processed at the meet. All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming coach card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck.

ADAPTED SWIMMING: Any current athlete members of USA Swimming with a disability as defined by USA Swimming Rules and Regulations may enter this meet. If modifications to USA Swimming rules are necessary then the coach or athlete must notify the meet referee of any disability prior to competition.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: Swimmers may enter 4 (four) individual events

ENTRY TIMES: Submit entry times in: SCY. If there are no official times for an athlete, please submit estimated times. No Times (NT) will not be accepted.

Entries will be handled on a first come first served basis; however, Connecticut teams will be given priority over out-of-state teams. The date the entry is received shall be determined by the email date and time or, if no electronic file is sent, on receipt of paper entry.

CONNECTICUT-ONLY DEADLINE: CT deadline is May 12, 2011. All entries received from Connecticut teams by that date will be given priority over out of state teams and swimmers. Entry date will be based on receipt of electronic file, or, if no file is sent on receipt of paper entry. CT clubs meeting this deadline will be entered before out of state clubs.

ELECTRONIC ENTRIES: Electronic entries (such as from Hy-Tek Team Manager or other team management software) that are in CL2 or SD3/SDIF format may be emailed as an attachment to the entry chair at Stephanie Jordan: sjordan@peco1938.com. Please check that your team name, address, and contact information are listed correctly in this file. Connecticut teams will be given priority over out-of-state teams. The date the entry is received shall be determined by the email date and time. Meet Managers reserves the right to limit heats, adjust warm-up and/or start times or make other changes to ensure a quality meet. All accepted will be notified as soon as the meet is full, but not later than May 19, 2011. If cuts or changes are made, the contact person listed on the entry will be notified.

ENTRIES FROM ATHLETES WITH NO CLUB AFFILIATION: Athletes entering this meet independent of a USA Swimming club or coach shall: 1.) be under the supervision of a USA Swimming coach for the duration of the meet. It is the swimmer's responsibility to make arrangements with a USA Swimming member coach prior to the meet. Athletes unaccompanied by a USA Swimming coach will not be permitted on deck. Please contact the Meet Director for assistance. 2) be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. The name of the USA Swimming member coach supervising the athlete and racing certification should be submitted to the Meet Director with the entry.

ENTRY FEES: Electronic entries: \$5.00 for individual events, \$11.00 for relays. Manual entries: \$8.00 for individual events, \$15.00 for relays events. No refunds will be given for entries that are accepted, or for entries that are rejected due to improper entry

CUT PROTOCOL: If a session is over-subscribed, relays will be cut first, followed by 6/Under swimmers, then 7/Under swimmers, and then all fourth events will be cut. If the time line estimate still exceeds four hours teams will be cut based on date of receipt. Clubs will be notified of cuts no later than Monday before the meet.

RESERVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE CHANGES: The meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet, with prior approval from Program Operations. Clubs will be notified of cuts no later than Monday before the meet.

RELAYS: Relays will be limited to 3 relays per team per event. All relay swimmers must be officially entered in the meet and attached to the relay club.

SAFETY:

1. Diving will be prohibited during warm-ups except in specifically announced one-way sprint lanes. There will be no diving in the warm-up and warm-down areas at any time
2. No shaving is permitted at the competition site.
3. No glass containers are permitted within the facility.
4. Swimmers must be under the supervision of a coach. If a swimmer arrives at the meet without a coach, the swimmer should notify the referee before he/she warms up. The referee will assign the swimmer to a registered coach for warm-ups.
5. No electronic devices with cameras are permitted in the locker rooms.

RULES: Current USA Swimming rules will govern all competition.

TIME TRIALS: Time trials will be offered at the discretion of the meet referee if time allows. Time trials are \$10.00 for individual events. Time trial events count toward the total number of event limitations per session.

TIMERS, OFFICIALS OR WORK ASSIGNMENTS: Timers will be asked to volunteer from the teams. We would greatly appreciate any team with officials that could help throughout the course of the meet. Please contact the Head Referee: Santos Carvajal-Gonzalez: santoscag@hotmail.com

DECK ACCESS: Only athletes, coaches, officials, and official meet staff actively participating in the meet are permitted on the pool deck.

SCORING: The meet will not be scored.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded to the top 8 finishers in each individual event, and top 3 finishers in each relay event.

CONCESSIONS: Yes.

HOSPITALITY FOR COACHES AND OFFICIALS: Yes.

PARKING: There is parking near the Larry Hart pool entrance and at the Ice Arena. Please respect handicapped parking areas, and no parking areas. Please do not park on the street. Choate Rosemary Hall Security patrols the area and can offer alternative parking areas.

DIRECTIONS: Take Exit 14 and turn right onto East Center Street. Go straight through four sets of lights. At the fifth light (Elm Street intersection), take a right. At the first stop sign (Christian Street), take a right for Johnson Athletic Center, and Larry Hart Pool. Turn right into the first parking lot. If additional events are going on, parking is also available at the Paul Mellon Arts Center.

From the north and south: Wilbur Cross Parkway (Rt. 15)

Take Exit 64 and turn right onto Quinnipiac St. Bear left at Wallace Park and cross over the R.R. tracks. Go straight through light (Quinnipiac becomes Center St. at this intersection). Turn left at second light (at top of hill) onto North Main St. Turn right at first stop sign onto Christian Street. Go straight through stop sign at bottom of hill (North Elm Street intersection). Look for Johnson Athletic Center; Larry Hart Pool.

From the south : I-91 Take Exit 14 and turn left onto Woodhouse Avenue (Rt. 150) At the second light, take a left onto Center St. At the third light (Elm Street intersection), take a right. The first stop sign is Christian Street, take a right for the Johnson Athletic Center, and the Paul Mellon Arts Center. Paul Mellon Arts Center and Johnson Athletic Center — first parking lot on the right.
