MEET CLASSIFICATION: This meet is open to all USA Swimming athletes and clubs.

MEET FORMAT: The meet will be swum as: Timed-Final. Events will be swum fast-to-slow, alternating heats of women and men.

SCRATCH PROCEDURES: Scratch Sheet due 30 before the beginning of each session.

FACILITY: The Westhill High School Pool is a 6-lane, 25-yard pool. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Water depth at start end is: 48 in. Water depth at turn end is: 48 in. Full Colorado timing system with spectator seating for 400.

DISABLED ACCESS: The pool is handicapped accessible. If you are in need of assistance contact a custodian or meet management.

EVENTS: See attached list.

SESSION TIMES: Session 1 (1650 free – Warm-up 7:30 am; Start 8:00). Session 2 (500 free and 400 IM – Warm-up 9 am, start 9:30 or immediately following 1650. Session will not begin prior to 9:30 am)

WARM-UPS: CT Swimming Warm-Up Procedures will be in effect.

ELIGIBILITY: All athletes must be current athlete members of USA Swimming. Age on the first day of the meet shall determine the swimmer's age and age group for the meet. Age on the first day of the meet shall determine the swimmer's age and age group for the meet. Any swimmer, who is entered and is unregistered, will be scratched from the meet until registration is completed. See CT Swimming athlete <u>registration</u> <u>procedures</u>. Registrations will not be processed at the meet. All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming

coach card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck.

ADAPTED SWIMMING: Any current athlete members of USA Swimming or CT with a disability as defined by USA Swimming Rules and Regulations may enter this meet. If modifications to USA Swimming rules are necessary then the coach or athlete must notify the meet referee of any disability prior to competition.

EVENT INFORMATION: Athletes need to supply their own timer and counter.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: Athletes can enter up to three events

All entries must be typed or printed legibly, and must use full names and registration numbers from USA Swimming registration. Entries will be considered received when the entry file is received (email or mail).

CONNECTICUT-ONLY DEADLINE: CT deadline is April 25, 2011. Entries will be considered received when the entry file is received (email or mail).

CT clubs meeting this deadline will be entered before out of state clubs.

ELECTRONIC ENTRIES: Electronic entries (such as from Hy-Tek Team Manager or other team management software) that are in CL2 or SD3/SDIF format may be emailed as an attachment to the entry chair at lewisshark@aol.com Please check that your team name, address, and contact information are listed correctly in this file. Payment must be received by May 4, 2011.

ENTRIES FROM ATHLETES WITH NO CLUB AFFILIATION: Athletes entering this meet independent of a USA Swimming club or coach shall: 1.) be under the supervision of a USA Swimming coach for the duration of the meet. It is the swimmer's responsibility to make arrangements with a USA Swimming member coach prior to the meet. Athletes unaccompanied by a USA Swimming coach will not be permitted on deck. Please contact the Meet Director for assistance. 2) be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. The name of the USA Swimming member coach supervising the athlete and racing certification should be submitted to the Meet Director with the entry.

ENTRY FEES: Electronic entries: \$6.00 for individual distance events. Manual entries: \$8.00 for individual distance events. No refunds will be given for entries that are accepted, or for entries that are rejected due to improper entry

CUT PROTOCOL for INVITATIONALS: If over subscribed, cuts will be made based upon date received. Clubs will be notified of cuts no later than Monday before the meet.

RESERVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE CHANGES: The meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet, with prior approval from Program Operations. Clubs will be notified of cuts no later than Monday before the meet.

SAFETY:
