MEET TYPE: Sanctioned

MEET CLASSIFICATION: This meet is open to all USA Swimming athletes and clubs.

MEET FORMAT: The meet will be swum as Timed-Final

SCRATCH PROCEDURES: Scratches will be due at 5:15 p.m.

FACILITY: The Yale Practice Pool is a 5 lane, 50 meter pool. Water depth at start end is 14 feet. Water depth at turn end is 4 feet. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Manual timing will be utilized. Spectator seating is limited. Bringing your own chair is recommended for spectators.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.

DISABLED ACCESS: Handicapped parking is available in front of Payne Whitney. The practice pool deck and spectator area are handicapped friendly. Contact the meet director for more information.

COURSE: LCM.

SESSION TIMES: Subject to Change 5:00 warm up – 5:40 start

WARM-UPS: CT Swimming Warm-Up Procedures will be in effect.

ELIGIBILITY: All athletes must be current athlete members of USA Swimming. Age on the first day of the meet shall determine the swimmer's age and age group for the meet. Age on the first day of the meet shall determine the swimmer's age and age group for the meet. Any swimmer, who is entered and is unregistered, will be scratched from the meet until registration is completed. See CT Swimming athlete [registration procedures](#). Registrations will not be processed at the meet. All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming

coach card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck.

ADAPTED SWIMMING: Any current athlete members of USA Swimming with a disability as defined by USA Swimming Rules and Regulations may enter this meet. If modifications to USA Swimming rules are necessary then the coach or athlete must notify the meet referee of any disability prior to competition. Adapted athletes may direct questions to [Mark Kinne](#), Adapted Athlete Committee Chair.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: Swimmers may compete in 1 event. The meet will be limited to 3 hours and 15 minutes of competition. The meet will be run fast to slow alternating women then men.

ENTRY TIMES: Submit entry times in: LCM. If there are no official times for an athlete, please submit estimated times. No Times (NT) will not be accepted.

DEADLINES: Entry deadline is May 31, 2013. Entries will be accepted in the order they are received, regardless of mode of delivery. Email is preferred method of entry: tim.wise@yale.edu

CONNECTICUT-ONLY DEADLINE: Connecticut entry deadline is May 30, 2013. CT clubs meeting this deadline will be entered before out of state clubs. Entries will be accepted in the order they are received, regardless of mode of delivery.

ELECTRONIC ENTRIES: Electronic entries (such as from Hy-Tek Team Manager or other team management software) that are in CL2 or SD3/SDIF format may be emailed as an attachment to the entry chair at tim.wise@yale.edu. Please check that your team name, address, and contact information are listed correctly in this file. Payment is due upon arrival at the meet. Teams will be notified upon receipt of entry of the entry's status regarding acceptance into the meet. In the event you do not receive entry status notification within 24 hours of emailing the entry, please contact the entry chair to verify your entry has been received.

ENTRIES FROM ATHLETES WITH NO CLUB AFFILIATION: Athletes entering this meet independent of a USA Swimming club or coach shall: 1.) be under the supervision of a USA Swimming coach for the duration of the meet. It is the swimmer's responsibility to make arrangements with a USA Swimming member coach prior to the meet. Athletes unaccompanied by a USA Swimming coach will not be permitted on deck. Please contact the Meet Director for assistance. 2) be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. The name of the USA Swimming member coach supervising the athlete and racing certification should be submitted to the Meet Director with the entry.

ENTRY FEES: Electronic entries: \$8.00. Manual entries: \$20.00. No refunds will be given for entries that are accepted, or for entries that are rejected due to improper entry.

CUT PROTOCOL: Teams will be notified of entry acceptance within 24 hours of entry arrival. In the event of over subscription the host will notify teams the Monday before the meet, at the latest.

RESERVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE CHANGES: The meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet, with prior approval from Program Operations. Clubs will be notified of changes no later than Monday before the meet.

SAFETY:

1. Diving will be prohibited during warm-ups except in specifically announced one-way sprint lanes. There will be no diving in the warm-up and warm-down areas at any time
2. No shaving is permitted at the competition site.
3. No glass containers are permitted within the facility.
4. Swimmers must be under the supervision of a coach. If a swimmer arrives at the meet without a coach, the swimmer should notify the referee before he/she warms up. The referee will assign the swimmer to a registered coach for warm-ups.
5. No electronic audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, are permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.

RULES: Current USA Swimming rules will govern all competition.

TIME TRIALS: Time trials will be offered at the discretion of the meet referee if time allows. Time trials are \$10.00 for individual events. Time trial events count toward the total number of event limitations per session. Time Trial events are limited to those events published in this meet announcement.

TIMERS, OFFICIALS OR WORK ASSIGNMENTS: Swimmers will be responsible to provide their own timer and counter.

DECK ACCESS: Only athletes, coaches, officials, and official meet staff actively participating in the meet are permitted on the pool deck.

SCORING: The meet will not be scored.

PARKING: Available in front of and behind the Payne Whitney Gymnasium.

DIRECTIONS: Take Exit 3 off of I - 91 (Trumbull Street). Go straight through three lights, at the fourth light take left (Prospect). At the next light take right (Grove street). Follow road through one light and Payne Whitney is straight ahead. Practice Pool is located on the third floor.
