MEET TYPE: Sanctioned

MEET CLASSIFICATION: This meet is open to all USA Swimming athletes and clubs.

MEET FORMAT: The meet will be swum as a Timed-Final. Events will be run fastest to slowest alternating girls and boys.

SCRATCH PROCEDURES: Coaches will receive a scratch sheet for each session of the meet in their meet packets listing all of their swimmers and events for each session. Scratch sheets will be due to the computer table 30 minutes after the start of warm ups; these must be returned even if a team has no scratches.

FACILITY: Zeigler Pool at the Darien YMCA is a 6 lane 25 yard pool. Water depth at start end is: 10 feet. Water depth at turn end is: 4 ½ feet. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Colorado timing will be used. Spectator seating of 150.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.

DISABLED ACCESS: The Darien YMCA is handicapped accessible with a special needs locker room and showers. Please contact Jason Cochran, 203.655.8228 x353 for more information and special arrangements.

WARM-UPS: CT Swimming Warm-Up Procedures will be in effect.

ELIGIBILITY: All athletes must be current athlete members of USA Swimming. Age on the first day of the meet shall determine the swimmer's age and age group for the meet. Age on the first day of the meet shall determine the swimmer's age and age group for the meet. Any swimmer, who is entered and is unregistered, will be scratched from the meet until registration is completed. See CT Swimming athlete [registration procedures](#). Registrations will not be processed at the meet. All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming coach card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck.

ADAPTED SWIMMING: Any current athlete members of USA Swimming with a disability as defined by USA Swimming Rules and Regulations may enter this meet. If modifications to USA Swimming rules are necessary then the coach or athlete must notify the meet referee of any disability prior to competition. Adapted athletes may direct questions to [Mark Kinne](#), Adapted Athlete Committee Chair.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: A swimmer may swim one individual event per day.

ENTRY TIMES: Submit entry times in SCY.

CT Only Deadline: May 15th. All CT Teams who submit their entry by this date will be guaranteed entry in the meet as long as the meet has not been closed due to prior oversubscription.

DEADLINES: Final entry deadline June 1st. Please send entry via email. No hardcopy necessary unless using 'snail' mail only. If hand writing, all entries must be typed or printed legibly, and must use full names and registration numbers from USA Swimming registration Mail hardcopy, if necessary, and payment to the entry chairperson:

ELECTRONIC ENTRIES: Electronic entries (such as from Hy-Tek Team Manager or other team management software) that are in CL2 or SD3/SDIF format may be emailed as an attachment to the entry chair at piranha@darien-ymca.org. Please check that your team name, address, and contact information are listed correctly in this file. ENTRIES FROM ATHLETES WITH NO CLUB AFFILIATION: Athletes entering this meet independent of a USA Swimming club or coach shall: 1.) be under the supervision of a USA Swimming coach for the duration of the meet. It is the swimmer's responsibility to make arrangements with a USA Swimming member coach prior to the meet. Athletes unaccompanied by a USA Swimming coach will not be permitted on deck. Please contact the Meet Director for assistance. 2) be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. The name of the USA Swimming member coach supervising the athlete and racing certification should be submitted to the Meet Director with the entry.

ENTRY FEES: Electronic entries: \$7 for individual events. Manual entries: \$14.00 for individual events. No refunds will be given for entries that are accepted, or for entries that are rejected due to improper entry.

Outreach: Participating clubs may request, via email, that individual entry fees be waived for Outreach athletes listed on the club's entry. See <http://ctswim.org/ctswim/policies/outreachentryfees.pdf> for policy and procedure

PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS: Checks payable to **Darien YMCA** and mail to the entry chair at the address listed above. Payment must be received by 6/5/13.

CUT PROTOCOL: CT teams whose entries are received by the CT deadline will be entered first, after which all other teams will be entered on a first-come, first-serve basis. Clubs will be notified of cuts no later than Monday before the meet.

RESERVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE CHANGES: The meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet, with prior approval from Program Operations. Clubs will be notified of changes no later than Monday before the meet.

RELAYS: No relays.

SAFETY:

1. Diving will be prohibited during warm-ups except in specifically announced one-way sprint lanes. There will be no diving in the warm-up and warm-down areas at any time
2. No shaving is permitted at the competition site.
3. No glass containers are permitted within the facility.
4. Swimmers must be under the supervision of a coach. If a swimmer arrives at the meet without a coach, the swimmer should notify the referee before he/she warms up. The referee will assign the swimmer to a registered coach for warm-ups.
5. No electronic audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, are permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.

RULES: Current USA Swimming rules will govern all competition.

TIMERS, OFFICIALS OR WORK ASSIGNMENTS: Swimmers must provide their own timers and counters. The Piranhas welcome anyone who wishes to assist in officiating during this meet. Please contact Gigi Kearney, chiquitapt@optonline.net. Participating clubs must be notified of work assignments by the Monday before the meet.

DECK ACCESS: Only athletes, coaches, officials, and official meet staff actively participating in the meet are permitted on the pool deck.

SCORING: The meet will not be scored.

AWARDS: None

CONCESSIONS: None, but the Y has vending machines and an Embody Café in the lobby of the building.

HOSPITALITY FOR COACHES AND OFFICIALS: A small coaches' and official's hospitality will be located on deck near the computer stand

DIRECTIONS:

I-95 Southbound: Exit 11, US 1 (Post Rd.) Darien. Take left at bottom of ramp onto US 1 South (West). Go through 5 stop lights. The YMCA will be on your left (small sign). If you enter Stamford, you've traveled too far.

I-95 Northbound: Exit 9. Take left at end of ramp. Take right at light onto US 1 North (East). Follow US 1 into Darien. YMCA will be on your right (small sign). If you hit a stop light, in Darien, you've traveled too far.

Merritt Parkway (Route 15): Exit 37, New Canaan & Darien. At the end of ramp, take a right onto CT 124. Follow CT 124 into Darien to intersection with US 1 (Post Rd.). Turn right onto US 1. Go through downtown Darien under RR truss and I-95 overpass. Go through 5 stop lights. The YMCA will be on your left (small sign). If you end up in Stamford, you've traveled too far.

PARKING: Parking can be done at the YMCA. Overflow parking is on Saltbox Lane (the side street next to the church across the street from the Y). NO PARKING AT THE CHURCH OR ON SEAVIEW AVE OR LIGHTHOUSE ROAD.
