We ARE accepting Deck Entries for meet registered swimmers wishing to add additional events until 8:30am for Session 1 and until 1:30pm for Session 2. Payment will be due at time of entry.

All entries must be legible and must use full names and registration numbers from USA Swimming registration.

ENTRY FEES: Electronic entries \$9.00 for individual events, \$18.00 for relays. Deck Entries/Manual entries: \$10.00 for individual events, \$20.00 for relays. No refunds will be given for entries that are accepted, or for entries that are rejected due to improper entry.

REGISTRATION REPORTING: The Meet or Entry Director MUST run a meet verification report and give said report to the Meet Referee. This is to ensure that no swimmer without their APT credentials or unregistered swimmers participate in a sanction USA/CT Swimming meet.

SANCTIONED OR APPROVED: Sanctioned

MEET DURATION: Full meet with time limits as defined by CT/USA Swimming.

MEET FORMAT: The meet will be swum as **Timed Finals.**

FACILITY: The Middletown Pool is a 6 -lane, 25-yard pool. Water depth at start end is: 12 Feet. Water depth at turn end is: 3 Feet. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming. We will be using Colorado System 6 timing with touch pads and back up buttons with two (2) manual back timers per lane. We will NOT be using backstroke ledges. There is ample spectator seating in bleachers elevated above the pool on the lane 6 side of the pool.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.

MEDICAL SUPERVISION: Lifeguards will be on duty during the meet and an AED is located in the entry hall.

WIFI ACCESS: WIFI will be available.

WARM-UPS: CT Swimming Warm-Up Procedures will be in effect. Session 1 (12& Unders): Warm-up Start:8:00am Warm-up End: 9:00am 6 lanes are available for warm up until 8:45am and 3 lanes will be designated as One-way Sprint starting at 8:45am. Session 2: (13&Overs): Warm-up Start:1:00pm Warm-up End: 2:00pm 6 lanes are available for warm up until 1:45pm and 3 lanes will be designated as One-way Sprint starting at 1:45pm.

EVENT INFORMATION: Deck entries will be accepted for swimmers already entered in the meet. The deadline for Session 1 is until 8:30am and Session 2 until 1:30pm. Deck entries will cost of \$10.00 per individual event and \$20.00 per relay event. There will be breaks of five (5) to ten (10) minutes scattered throughout the meet at the discretion of the meet director and meet referee.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: All athletes are limited to Five (5) Individual Events and Two (2) Relay Events per day maximum.

SCRATCH PROCEDURES: All Scratches or event changes are due to the Timers' Table/ Administrative Officials by 8:30am for Session 1 and 1:30pm for Session 2. Any swimmer wishing to scratch an event after this dead line must notify or have their coach notify the Deck Referee and they will be charged a Declared False Start (DFS).

SAFE SPORT POLICIES: Spectators will be allowed as there is ample spectator seating. All Coaches, Officials, Deck Staff, and Athletes age 18 and over will be required to follow Safe Sport Athlete Protection

Policies. A separate bathroom/ changing area will be available for USA Swimming officials and coaches, deck staff, and competitors over age 18.

DISABLED ACCESS: The Pool Deck for Middletown Recreation Center is handicap accessible. Handicap Parking, and locker rooms are available. For more information, please contact person listed on page 1.

ELIGIBILITY: All USA Swimming clubs and individuals; Athletes with Flex memberships must not have swum in more than one USA Swimming meet prior to this meet in order to be eligible.

All athletes must be current athlete members of USA Swimming. Age on the first day of the meet shall determine the swimmer's age and age group for the meet. Any swimmer, who is entered and is unregistered, will be scratched from the meet until registration is completed. See CT Swimming athlete <u>registration</u> <u>procedures</u>. Registrations will not be processed at the meet. All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming coach card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck Clubs are reminded that participation of unregistered swimmers and/or coaches will result in a **\$100 fine** per instance, as described in CT Swimming meet policies:

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water **without the use of the backstroke ledge.** When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

ADAPTED SWIMMING: Any current athlete members of USA Swimming with a disability as defined by USA Swimming Rules and Regulations may enter this meet. If modifications to USA Swimming rules are necessary then the coach or athlete must notify the meet referee of any disability <u>prior</u> to competition. Adapted athletes may direct questions to the <u>Connecticut Swimming office</u>.

ENTRY TIMES: Submit entry times in: SCY if an athlete does not have any established time (SCY or Conversion from SCM or LCM), please enter them as NT (NO TIME).

ELECTRONIC ENTRIES: Electronic entries (such as from Hy-Tek Team Manager or other team management software) that are in CL2 or SD3/SDIF format may be emailed as an attachment to the entry chair at <u>william.evison@gmail.com</u>. Please check that your team name, address, and contact information are listed correctly in this file. Event entries and payments should be received no later than November 19, 2023. Deck entries are subject to a \$1.00 late fee per individual event (\$10.00 per event fee instead of \$9.00 per event) and a \$2.00 late fee per Relay Event (\$20.00 per relay instead of \$18.00) Payment is due November 26, 2023 at time of entry.

ENTRIES FROM ATHLETES WITH NO CLUB AFFILIATION: Athletes entering this meet independent of a USA Swimming club or coach shall: 1.) be under the supervision of a USA Swimming coach for the duration of the meet. It is the swimmer's responsibility to make arrangements with a USA Swimming member coach prior to the meet. Athletes unaccompanied by a USA Swimming coach will not be permitted on deck. Please contact the Meet Director for assistance. 2) be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. The name of the USA Swimming member coach supervising the athlete and racing certification should be submitted to the Meet Director with the entry.

All adult athletes, or parents of minor athletes, who enter without club affiliation will be required to attest to reading and understanding the <u>Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy</u>.

OUTREACH ENTRY FEE REIMBURSEMENT: Participating clubs will submit payment in full to the meet host for all Outreach athlete entry fees (splash fees). These fees will be reimbursed by CSI to the participating CSI club after completion of the meet. Scratches and 'No Swims' will not be reimbursed. CUT PROTOCOL:

If the session is oversubscribed the following protocol will be instituted IN THE ORDER PRESENTED to reduce the timeline to the required length or participation number:

- 1. Athletes aged 7 and Under will be cut from the meet.
- 2. All relays, if planned, will be eliminated.
- 3. The distance events (400 meters or greater) may be heat limited to the first TWO (2) heats of entries per gender <u>in the order they were received</u>.
- 4. The maximum number of events allowed per day may be reduced by one (1).
- 5. Visiting teams may be cut based on the date/time of the receipt of the final paid entry. If teams are cut, the host reserves the right to offer the available partial entry to the cut teams in the order that entries were received in order to fill the meet.

The host reserves the right to seek approval from Program Operations for additional changes, which may reasonably maximize participation opportunities.

Notification of any cuts or requests for changes must be made to Program Operations as soon as possible by the host. Attending teams will be notified no later than the Monday before the meet.

NOTE: If the host is required to institute the published cut protocol above. All accepted entries at the time that the cut protocol is instituted may be considered final by the host for the purposes of financial responsibility. (i.e. Teams submitting "placeholder" entries will be required to pay for the entries if the cut protocol is required).

RESERVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE CHANGES: In accordance with CSI Policies, the meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet. The Meet Referee will seek Program Operations approval for all changes requiring approval. Clubs will be notified of changes no later than Monday before the meet.

RELAYS: Yes. There will be no team limitations on relays. All relay swimmers must be officially entered in the meet. Mixed relays maybe allowed and counted as a time trial event at the Late Entry relay price. All mixed relays must be made up of Two (2) Male and Two (2) Female Swimmers. Each Swimmer will be allowed a Maximum of Two (2) Relay Entries (1 Medley Relay and/or 1 Freestyle Relay).

SAFETY:

- 1. Diving will be prohibited during warm-ups except in specifically announced one-way sprint lanes. There will be no diving in the warm-up and warm-down areas at any time
- 2. No shaving is permitted at the competition site.
- 3. No glass containers are permitted within the facility.
- 4. Swimmers must be under the supervision of a coach. If a swimmer arrives at the meet without a coach, the swimmer should notify the referee before he/she warms up. The referee will assign the swimmer to a registered coach for warm-ups.

5. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

SWIMWEAR: Per CT Swimming policy, swimmers 12 years old and younger are not permitted to wear "Tech Suits" at any CT sanctioned or approved meets. "Tech Suits" are defined as a suit that has Bonded Seams, Kinetic Tape, or Meshed Seams. Age is determined on the first date of the meet.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO RECORDING:

Meet Management has the full authority to restrict any and all photography, audio and visual recording using cameras, video cameras, tablets, cell phones or other electronic devices at a meet.

Photography or video recording from the deck is prohibited by all individuals, other than participating Coaches, unless prior authorization from the Meet Referee or meet referee has been granted.

Under no circumstances is photography or video recording permitted by anyone in the area adjacent to or behind the starting blocks, including spectator stands at deck level, while they are in use for race starting purposes during competition and warm-ups. Flash photography is prohibited during the start of any heat, including whenever any swimmer is stepping up or standing on a block for the purpose of the start of a heat.

Photography or video recording and the use of audio, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Additional "No Camera Zones" may be designated by Meet Management or the meet referee.

If individuals are properly credentialed, not obstructing movement on the deck and abiding by these rules, the following individuals may be allowed by Meet Management and the meet referee with prior authorization if they possess the following:

- Professional photographers with current, official media credentials that are promoting the sport of swimming
- Official team and professional meet photographers that are USA Swimming members, background checked, have signed off on MAAPP and completed Athlete Protection Training
- A participating athlete directly assisting a Coach, for instructional purposes, during an event using the Coach's electronic device

Any individual failing to abide by these rules may be ejected from the facility and be subject to a Code of Conduct violation at the discretion of Meet Management.

If individuals are properly credentialed, not obstructing movement on the deck and abiding by these rules, the following individuals may be allowed by Meet Management and the meet referee with prior authorization if they possess the following:

- Professional photographers with current, official media credentials that are promoting the sport of swimming
- Official team and professional meet photographers that are USA Swimming members, background checked, have signed off on MAAPP and completed Athlete Protection Training
- A participating athlete directly assisting a Coach, for instructional purposes, during an event using the Coach's electronic device

DRONES: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by USA Swimming Vice President of Program Operations.

RULES: Current USA Swimming rules will govern all competition.

TIME TRIALS: Yes. Time trials may be offered at the discretion of the Meet Referee in accordance with CSI Policy if time allows. Time trials are limited to the events published in this meet announcement (age/distance/stroke). Time Trials will count toward the athlete's event limitations for the day and meet. If they are offered, only athletes properly entered in one or more events in the meet are eligible for time trials and must be properly entered in the Time Trial. The deadline for Time Trial entries is/are 8:30am for morning sessions and 1:30pm for afternoon sessions. The fee for Time Trial entries are \$15.00 for individual events and \$20.00 for relays. (See info regarding Mixed Relays.) Any Swimmer doing a time trial will be required to provide their own timer. Additionally, 500 Free swimmers will need to provide both a timer and a counter.

TIMERS, OFFICIALS OR WORK ASSIGNMENTS: Any Swimmer doing a time trial will be required to provide their own timer. Additionally, 500 Free swimmers will need to provide both a timer AND a counter. Any official looking to work should email The Meet Referee, with a screen shot of their current certification(s). Participating clubs will be notified of work assignments by the Monday before the meet.

All volunteers will be required to attest to reading and understanding the <u>Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention</u> <u>Policy.</u>

DECK ACCESS: Only athletes, coaches, officials, and official meet staff actively participating in the meet are permitted on the pool deck.

SCORING: The meet will not be scored.

AWARDS: No. However, All HEAT WINNERS will receive a rubber duck as an award at the conclusion of their heat.

CONCESSIONS: No.

HOSPITALITY FOR COACHES AND OFFICIALS: Yes.

PARKING: Ample Parking at the Beman Middle School Parking lot. Officials, coaches and handicapped individuals can park directly in front and to the right to the Recreation Center.
