MEET DURATION: Full meet with time limits as defined by CT/USA Swimming;

MEET FORMAT: The meet will be swum as Timed-Final. The 400 IM, 500 Free, and 1650 Free, will be done fastest to slowest alternating girls & boys. Heats may be combined at the referee's discretion. Due to the depth of the water at the starting end all events will begin in the water.

SCRATCH PROCEDURES: Scratches are due by 7:45 am

FACILITY: Westhill HS is a 6-lane, 25-yard pool. Water depth at start end is: 3 feet 6 inches. Water depth at turn end is: 3 feet 6 inches. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The facility has full Colorado electronic timing and seating for 400 people.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.

All events begin in the water.

DISABLED ACCESS: Handicapped parking, handicapped entrances and the pool, locker rooms and spectator areas are all accessible. Call 203-912-9385 for more information and special arrangements.

SESSION TIMES: Subject to Change

Session 1: Warmup: 7:30am Start 8:10am

Session 2 (1650 Free): Warmup immediately following session 1 (20 min). Start no earlier than 9:30am

WARM-UPS: CT Swimming Warm-Up Procedures will be in effect. Session 1: Warmup: 7:30 am

ELIGIBILITY: All USA Swimming clubs and individuals; All athletes must be current athlete members of USA Swimming. Age on the first day of the meet shall determine the swimmer's age and age group for the meet. List any restrictions, such as age, etc. Any swimmer, who is entered and is unregistered, will be scratched from the meet until registration is completed. See CT Swimming athlete <u>registration procedures</u>. Registrations will not be processed at the meet. All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming coach card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck Clubs are reminded that participation of unregistered swimmers and/or coaches will result in a \$100 fine per instance, as described in CT Swimming meet policies:

ADAPTED SWIMMING: Any current athlete members of USA Swimming with a disability as defined by USA Swimming Rules and Regulations may enter this meet. If modifications to USA Swimming rules are necessary then the coach or athlete must notify the meet referee of any disability <u>prior</u> to competition. Adapted athletes may direct questions to the <u>Connecticut Swimming office</u>.

EVENT INFORMATION: Swimmers must provide their own timers and counters

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: Swimmers may compete in a maximum of 3 events.

ENTRY TIMES: Submit entry times in SCY

DEADLINES: deadline is January 31,2019. Mail hardcopy and payment to the entry chairperson: Rick Lewis; 212 Palmer Hill Rd; Old Greenwich, CT 06870. All entries must be legible and must use full names and registration numbers from USA Swimming registration. The date an entry is received is determined by the date the entry file is received whether by email, delivery, or snail mail.

CONNECTICUT-ONLY DEADLINE: CT deadline is January 15, 2019. CT clubs meeting this deadline will be entered before out of state clubs.

ELECTRONIC ENTRIES: Electronic entries (such as from Hy-Tek Team Manager or other team management software) that are in CL2 or SD3/SDIF format may be emailed as an attachment to the entry chair at lewisshark@aol.com Please check that your team name, address, and contact information are listed correctly in this file. Payment is due by November 15, 2018

ENTRIES FROM ATHLETES WITH NO CLUB AFFILIATION: Athletes entering this meet independent of a USA Swimming club or coach shall: 1.) be under the supervision of a USA Swimming coach for the duration of the meet. It is the swimmer's responsibility to make arrangements with a USA Swimming member coach prior to the meet. Athletes unaccompanied by a USA Swimming coach will not be permitted on deck. Please contact the Meet Director for assistance. 2) be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. The name of the USA Swimming member coach supervising the athlete and racing certification should be submitted to the Meet Director with the entry.

ENTRY FEES: Electronic entries: \$8.00 for individual events, \$8.00 for distance events. Manual entries: \$10.00 for individual events, \$10.00 for distance events. No refunds will be given for entries that are accepted, or for entries that are rejected due to improper entry.

CUT PROTOCOL:

If the session is oversubscribed the following protocol will be instituted IN THE ORDER PRESENTED to reduce the timeline to the required length or participation number:

- 1. Athletes aged 7 and Under will be cut from the meet. (Should not be used for 8/U meets)
- 2. All relays, if planned, will be eliminated.
- 3. The distance events (400 meters or yards or greater) may be heat limited to the first 4 heats of entries per gender in the order they were received.
- 4. The maximum number of events allowed per day may be reduced by one (1).
- 5. Visiting teams may be cut based on the date/time of the receipt of the final paid entry. If teams are cut, the host reserves the right to offer the available partial entry to the cut teams in the order that entries were received in order to fill the meet.

The host reserves the right to seek approval from Program Operations for additional changes, which may reasonably maximize participation opportunities.

Notification of any cuts or requests for changes must be made to Program Operations as soon as possible by the host. Attending teams will be notified no later than the Monday before the meet.

NOTE: If the host is required to institute the published cut protocol above. All accepted entries at the time that the cut protocol is instituted may be considered final by the host for the purposes of financial responsibility. (i.e. Teams submitting "placeholder" entries will be required to pay for the entries if the cut protocol is required).

RESERVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE CHANGES: In accordance with CSI Policies, the meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet. The Meet Referee will seek Program Operations approval for all changes requiring approval. Clubs will be notified of changes no later than Monday before the meet.

RELAYS: No.

SAFETY:

- 1. Diving will be prohibited during warm-ups except in specifically announced one-way sprint lanes. There will be no diving in the warm-up and warm-down areas at any time
- 2. No shaving is permitted at the competition site.
- 3. No glass containers are permitted within the facility.
- 4. Swimmers must be under the supervision of a coach. If a swimmer arrives at the meet without a coach, the swimmer should notify the referee before he/she warms up. The referee will assign the swimmer to a registered coach for warm-ups.
- 5. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO RECORDING:

Meet Management has the full authority to restrict any and all photography and visual recording at the meet. Photography or video recording (using cameras, video cameras, iPads, cell phones, etc) from the deck is prohibited by all individuals other than participating Coach and Athlete Members unless prior authorization from the Meet Referee or his/her designee has been granted. Flash photography is prohibited

during the start of any heat, including whenever any swimmer is stepping up or standing on a block for the purpose of the start of a heat.

Additionally, the following "Non-Camera Zones" shall be enforced:

- Photography or video recording and the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Photography or video recording (using cameras, video cameras, iPads, cell phones, etc) is not permitted in the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) while they are in use for "race starting purposes" during competition and warm-ups.
- Additional "Non-Camera Zones" may be designated by Meet Management.

Any individual failing to abide by these rules may be ejected from the facility and be subject to a Code of Conduct violation at the discretion of Meet Management.

DRONES: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the USA Swimming Vice President of Program Operations.

RULES: Current USA Swimming rules will govern all competition.

TIME TRIALS: No

TIMERS, OFFICIALS OR WORK ASSIGNMENTS: Swimmers must supply their own timers and counters

DECK ACCESS: Only athletes, coaches, officials, and official meet staff actively participating in the meet are permitted on the pool deck.

SCORING: The meet will not be scored.

AWARDS: No.

CONCESSIONS: No.

HOSPITALITY FOR COACHES AND OFFICIALS: Minimal

PARKING: You must park in a legal parking spot.

DIRECTIONS: Westhill HS Pool is located at 125 Roxbury Rd in Stamford, CT Merritt Parkway to Long Ridge Rd. (Exit 34). From the North turn left onto Long Ridge Rd. From the South turn Right onto Longe Ridge Rd. Proceed about 1 mile. Take a hard right at the light onto Roxbury Rd. School is ½ mile up the street on the right. The pool is in the rear by the loading dock.
