**SCRATCH PROCEDURES:** Scratch sheet will be given to the coaching staffs prior to the start of each session. At that point team will be able to scratch athletes from the session, but still be responsible for the fees.

# **BEFORE ENTERING FACILITY or WHAT TO BRING:**

### Northeast CT Aquatics reserves the right to revise rules with ever-changing conditions on Covid.

• Spectators are allowed only in a designated area only! A live-stream of the meet will be offered. Details of the live-stream will be sent out closer to the event date. Just a reminder that the second floor has windows overlooking the pool. Parents are not allowed to gather there to watch or video the swim meet. Failure to comply will result in a dismissal of family, including swimmer from the competition.

Again, Northeast CT Aquatics reserves the right to revise rules with ever-changing conditions on Covid.

• Designated bathrooms are assigned, and usage will be restricted to 1 person at a time. Coaches, Officials, and Support Staff will use the locker room. Swimmers will have use of the bathrooms in the dome during the meet. Parent should use the bathroom in the main lobby on the first floor.

- Swimmers must remain off the pool deck unless they are warming up or racing.
- Swimmers will need to bring their own Chairs/Blankets/extra towels.
- There will be designated areas for teams to set up within the dome that's next to the building where the pool is. There is no chairs or food allowed on the turf. All chairs and food should remain on the track.
- Announcements will be made periodically as reminders of events.
- A single heat will be allowed behind the block at a time, the next heat will be staged at the bullpen area.
- Swimmers must walk to their lanes 1 going first and 6 going last.
- Swimmers must walk up to the blocks with masks and leave them with their warmups/sweatshirt/pants.

• Once the race is complete, they will exit the pool, put their masks on and return to their area to dry off. The route athletes must take is on the attached map.

• Swimmers will exit pool, walk along the lane 6 wall side of the pool, around the shallow end, then exit the pool deck thru the hallway door near the lane 1 side. Athletes will then follow the hallway to the dome and then to their designated team areas.

**FACILITY:** Star Hill Family Athletic Center is an 6 -lane, 25-yard pool. Water depth at start end is: 12ft. Water depth at turn end is: 4ft. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming. Colorado timing system will be used and results will be posted in the hallway outside of the pool.

**SAFE SPORT POLICIES: Spectators are allowed only in a designated area only!** A live-stream of the meet will be offered. Details of the live-stream will be sent out closer to the event date. Just a reminder that the second floor has windows overlooking the pool. **Parents are not allowed to gather there to watch or video the swim meet.** 

**DISABLED ACCESS:** Handicap accessibility throughout the facility.

SESSION TIMES: Subject to Change Northeast CT Aquatics reserves the right to revise rules with ever-changing conditions on Covid. Friday – Warmup 5:00p/Start 6:00p Saturday/Sunday AM (13&O) – Warmup 7:00a/Start 9:00a Saturday/Sunday PM (12&U) – Warmup 12:00p/Start 1:30p.

WARM-UPS: CT Swimming Warm-Up Procedures will be in effect.

Northeast CT Aquatics reserves the right to revise rules with ever-changing conditions on Covid.

• Each team will have 20 mins and all 6 lanes to use for warmup.

- The order in which teams warmup will be determined sooner to the meet date
- Warm-up procedures will be published and distributed before meet.

**ELIGIBILITY:** All USA Swimming clubs and individuals; Athletes with Flex memberships must not have swum in more than one USA Swimming meet prior to this meet in order to be eligible.

All athletes must be current athlete members of USA Swimming. Age on the first day of the meet shall determine the swimmer's age and age group for the meet. Any swimmer, who is entered and is unregistered, will be scratched from the meet until registration is completed. See CT Swimming athlete <u>registration</u> <u>procedures</u>. Registrations will not be processed at the meet. All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming coach card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck Clubs are reminded that participation of unregistered swimmers and/or coaches will result in a **\$100 fine** per instance, as described in CT Swimming meet policies:

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water **without the use of the backstroke ledge.** When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

**ADULT ATHLETES:** All athletes who will be 18 years of age or older must complete the mandatory Athlete Protection Training prior to competition. Failure to do so will result in the swimmer being scratched from the meet.

**ADAPTED SWIMMING:** Any current athlete members of USA Swimming with a disability as defined by USA Swimming Rules and Regulations may enter this meet. If modifications to USA Swimming rules are necessary then the coach or athlete must notify the meet referee of any disability <u>prior</u> to competition. Adapted athletes may direct questions to the <u>Connecticut Swimming office</u>.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: 3 events per day maximum.

**DEADLINES:** deadline is October 1, 2021. Mail hardcopy and payment to the entry chairperson: Rob Ensling 681 Graham Road, South Windsor, CT, 06074. All entries must be legible and must use full names and registration numbers from USA Swimming registration. Date of entry will be determined by payment receipt.

**CONNECTICUT-ONLY DEADLINE (Optional for Short Course):** CT deadline is October 1, 2021; payment receipt determines entry date. CT clubs meeting this deadline will be entered before out of state clubs.

**ELECTRONIC ENTRIES:** Electronic entries (such as from Hy-Tek Team Manager or other team management software) that are in CL2 or SD3/SDIF format may be emailed as an attachment to the entry chair at rensling@gmail.com. Please check that your team name, address, and contact information are listed correctly in this file. Payment must be received by 10/08/21.

**ENTRIES FROM ATHLETES WITH NO CLUB AFFILIATION**: Athletes entering this meet independent of a USA Swimming club or coach shall: 1.) be under the supervision of a USA Swimming coach for the duration of the meet. It is the swimmer's responsibility to make arrangements with a USA Swimming member coach prior to the meet. Athletes unaccompanied by a USA Swimming coach will not be permitted on deck. Please contact the Meet Director for assistance. 2) be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. The name of the USA Swimming member coach supervising the athlete and racing certification should be submitted to the Meet Director with the entry.

All athletes, and their parents, who enter without club affiliation will be required to attest to reading and understanding the <u>Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy</u>.

**ENTRY FEES:** Electronic entries: \$10.00 for individual events, \$10.00 for distance event, \$10.00 for relays. Manual entries: \$10.00 for individual events, \$10.00 for distance events, \$20.00 for relays. In the case of approved meets, include any per swimmer fees. No refunds will be given for entries that are accepted, or for entries that are rejected due to improper entry.

**OUTREACH ENTRY FEE REIMBURSEMENT**: Participating clubs will submit payment in full to the meet host for all Outreach athlete entry fees (splash fees). These fees will be reimbursed by CSI to the participating CSI club after completion of the meet. Scratches and 'No Swims' will not be reimbursed. # **CUT PROTOCOL:**

If the session is oversubscribed the following protocol will be instituted IN THE ORDER PRESENTED to reduce the timeline to the required length or participation number:

- 1. All relays, if planned, will be eliminated.
- 2. The maximum number of events allowed per day may be reduced by one (1).

3. Visiting teams may be cut based on the date/time of the receipt of the final paid entry. If teams are cut, the host reserves the right to offer the available partial entry to the cut teams in the order that entries were received in order to fill the meet.

The host reserves the right to seek approval from Program Operations for additional changes, which may reasonably maximize participation opportunities.

Notification of any cuts or requests for changes must be made to Program Operations as soon as possible by the host. Attending teams will be notified no later than the Monday before the meet.

NOTE: If the host is required to institute the published cut protocol above. All accepted entries at the time that the cut protocol is instituted may be considered final by the host for the purposes of financial responsibility. (i.e. Teams submitting "placeholder" entries will be required to pay for the entries if the cut protocol is required).

**RESERVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE CHANGES:** In accordance with CSI Policies, the meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet. The Meet Referee will seek Program Operations approval for all changes requiring approval. Clubs will be notified of changes no later than Monday before the meet.

**RELAYS:** Yes. All relay swimmers must be officially entered in the meet.

# SAFETY:

- 1. Diving will be prohibited during warm-ups except in specifically announced one-way sprint lanes. There will be no diving in the warm-up and warm-down areas at any time
- 2. No shaving is permitted at the competition site.
- 3. No glass containers are permitted within the facility.
- 4. Swimmers must be under the supervision of a coach. If a swimmer arrives at the meet without a coach, the swimmer should notify the referee before he/she warms up. The referee will assign the swimmer to a registered coach for warm-ups.
- 5. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

**SWIMWEAR:** Per CT Swimming policy, swimmers 12 years old and younger are not permitted to wear "Tech Suits" at any CT sanctioned or approved meets. "Tech Suits" are defined as a suit that has Bonded Seams, Kinetic Tape, or Meshed Seams. Age is determined on the first date of the meet.

# PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO RECORDING:

Meet Management has the full authority to restrict any and all photography and visual recording at the meet. Photography or video recording (using cameras, video cameras, iPads, cell phones, etc) from the deck is prohibited by all individuals other than participating Coach and Athlete Members unless prior authorization from the Meet Referee or his/her designee has been granted. Flash photography is prohibited during the start of any heat, including whenever any swimmer is stepping up or standing on a block for the purpose of the start of a heat.

Additionally, the following "Non-Camera Zones" shall be enforced:

- Photography or video recording and the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Photography or video recording (using cameras, video cameras, iPads, cell phones, etc) is not permitted in the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) while they are in use for "race starting purposes" during competition and warm-ups.
- Additional "Non-Camera Zones" may be designated by Meet Management.

Any individual failing to abide by these rules may be ejected from the facility and be subject to a Code of Conduct violation at the discretion of Meet Management.

If individuals are properly credentialed, not obstructing movement on the deck and abiding by these rules, the following individuals may be allowed by Meet Management and the meet referee with prior authorization if they possess the following:

Professional photographers with current, official media credentials that are promoting the sport of swimming

Official team and professional meet photographers that are USA Swimming members, background checked, have signed off on MAAPP and completed Athlete Protection Training

A participating athlete directly assisting a Coach, for instructional purposes, during an event using the Coach's electronic device

**DRONES**: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the USA Swimming Vice President of Program Operations.

RULES: Current USA Swimming Rules will govern this meet.

# TIME TRIALS: No

**TIMERS, OFFICIALS OR WORK ASSIGNMENTS:** Yes teams will need to provide timers. Participating clubs will be notified of work assignments by the Monday before the meet.

All volunteers will be required to attest to reading and understanding the <u>Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention</u> <u>Policy.</u>

**DECK ACCESS:** Only athletes, coaches, officials, and official meet staff actively participating in the meet are permitted on the pool deck.

**SCORING:** The meet will not be scored. If scoring, please state the individual and relay point values.

**AWARDS:** Heat winners.
